



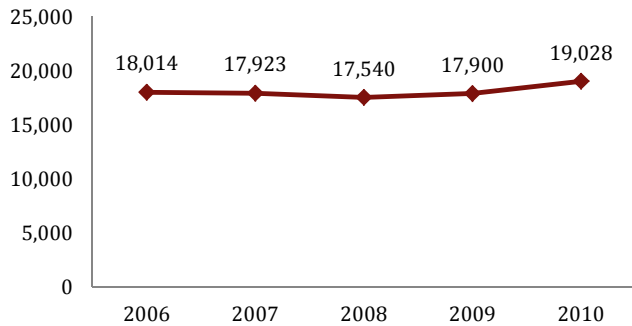

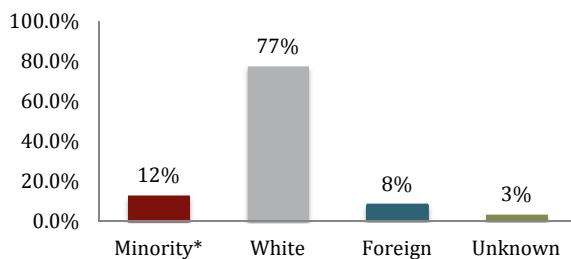

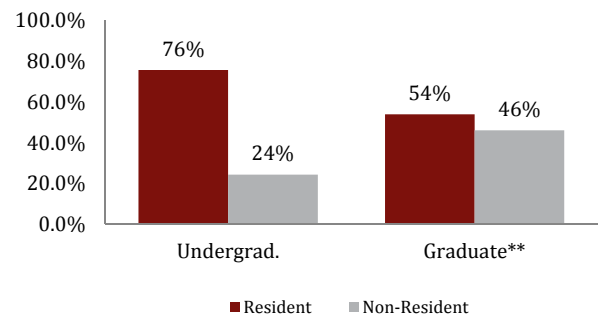

### Completions By Residency

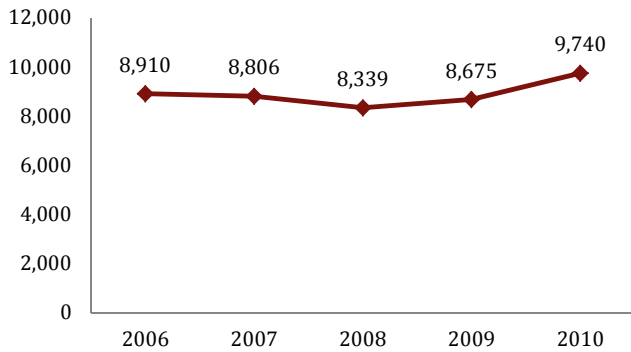

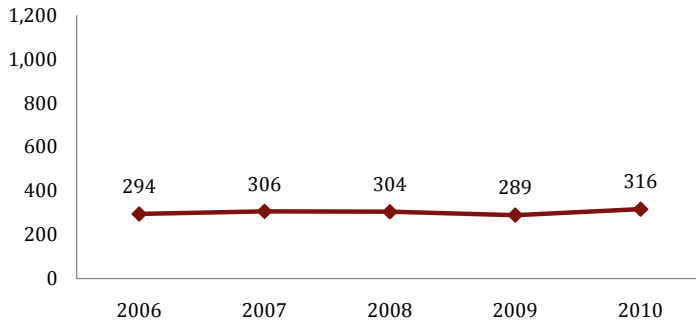


**Completions By Residency**

**Completions By Ethnicity**



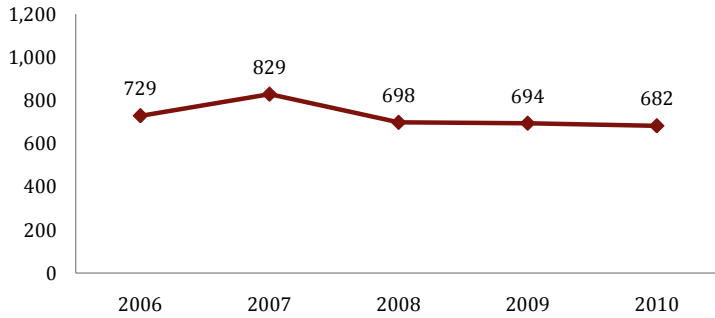
**Completions By Age**
