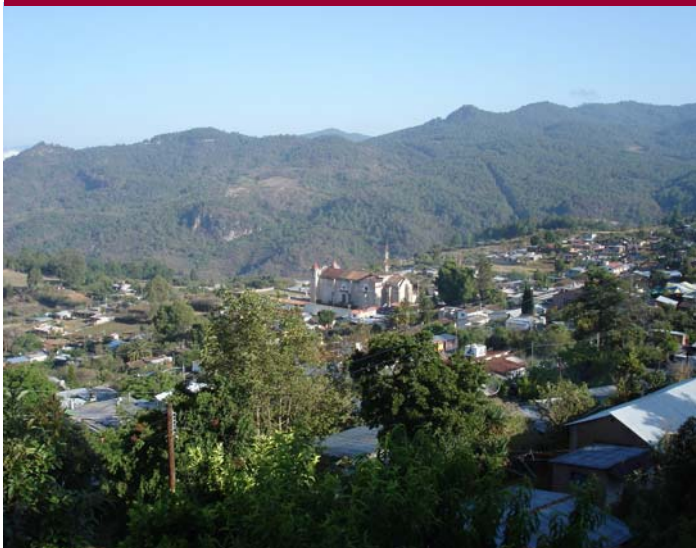

**May 19—June 9, 2008**

This program introduces students to a broad range of anthropological topics, including heritage and cultural patrimony, linguistic change, cultural diversity, economic revitalization and human-environment interactions. Students will meet local activists, students, and community members, and in the process, experience Oaxaca's tremendous cultural diversity. In Oaxaca City, students will learn about linguistics, the arts, and archaeology, visit museums, archives, archaeological sites, markets, and arts events. After this, we will travel to the different regions of the state where each of us maintains active field research: the high mountains of the Sierra Norte, the Sierra Mixe, the low-lying Isthmus of Tehuantepec, and the Pacific coast. Students will consider the production of anthropological knowledge and experience first-hand how anthropological research is done. This is a 3-credit, 3-week course offered through Overseas Study and is available to undergraduate students by application only.
