Executive Committee

The Director names annually an Executive Committee of 5-6 members from among active faculty affiliated with the Polish Studies Center. Every effort is made to ensure that the Committee represents a broad range of the disciplines in Polish Studies, including at least one member from outside the College. Members of the Executive Committee serve for terms of one year, and may be reappointed without limit.

The Executive Committee meets at least once a semester. The Director sets the agenda; any member of the Executive Committee may add items to that agenda.

The Executive Committee advises the Director on the strategic direction of the Center, including relations with other units, fundraising priorities, and programming.

The Executive Committee advises the Dean on the selection of a Director.

Scholarship Committee

The Director appoints each year a Scholarship committee, chosen from among affiliated faculty.
