ELIGIBILITY/SPECIFICATIONS:

The W.V.A. is open to all artists living within a 200 mile radius of Richmond, Indiana.

Each artist may submit a total of 2 works. The categories are drawings, paintings and prints.

Each work must be framed or ready for hanging.

We only accept hand delivered entries. **WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY SHIPPED OR MAILED ENTRIES.**

Works must not exceed 7' x 7' in size.

ENTRY FEE:

\$5.00 for one entry, or \$7.50 for two entries.

DELIVERY OF ENTRIES:

All work must be delivered between Saturday, March 24th and Friday, March 30th. Indiana University East will be open to accept entries on those days.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY SHIPPED OR MAILED ENTRIES.

LIABILITY RIGHTS AND CONDITIONS:

The greatest care will be taken in handling all entries; however, the W.V.A. will not be responsible for loss or damage which might occur. Only those entries accepted will be insured for the duration of the exhibit.

The W.V.A. reserves the right to photograph and reproduce entries for publicity purposes and records.

The submission of an entry to the W.V.A. shall be an agreement on the part of the artist to all listed conditions.

Works will be juried.

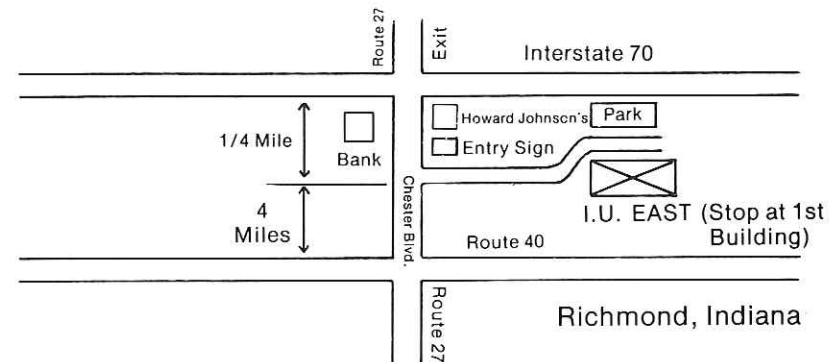
SUNDAY, APRIL 1st
