

Danny Barber began playing the trumpet in South Bend, Indiana, at the age of 10. After graduating from Clay High School he joined the U.S. Army Studio Band in Washington D.C. and toured the United States for three years. After leaving the service band, he went directly on the road with the Tommy Dorsey Band, then on to the Maynard Ferguson Band, and after moving to Chicago, became one of the most sought after studio and Broadway musicians in the "Windy City". Danny has performed with Henry Mancini,

Tony Bennet, Ann Margaret, Ray Charles, Dizzy Gillespie, Joe Williams, Nancy Wilson, Kenny Rogers, *Les Miserables* and *Phantom of the Opera*. He has also performed with the St. Louis Symphony, the Utah Symphony, The Midwest Pops, and the Chicago Symphony.
