Resolution Opposing House Joint Resolution 006

The Bloomington Faculty Council joined the University Faculty Council of Indiana University in opposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Indiana which recognized only marriages between one man and one woman. It also endorsed the university's decision to join the Freedom Indiana Coalition in opposition to the proposal and urged other faculty governance bodies as well as additional faculty, staff and student organizations at Indiana University Bloomington to adopt similar resolutions.

Resolution Instituting ROTC Priority Registration

The Bloomington Faculty Council adopted a resolution that the IUSA Student Body Congress should charge the Student Body President to suggest to the IU Office of Enrollment Management that ROTC students should be given priority registration rights and that the executive branch should gather and present data detailing the advantages of ROTC priority registration in order to demonstrate to the administration the importance of the issue.

Approval of Revisions to the IU Bloomington Principles and Policies on Tenure and Promotion

The Bloomington Faculty Council approved revisions to the IU Bloomington Principles and Policies on Tenure and Promotion. The document is intended to serve as a guarantee of to a fair, transparent, timely and procedurally solid tenure and promotion process including appeals. It was designed to be cognizant of the roles of interdisciplinarity, the advent of new media as well as new ways to express creative activities, research and scholarship in the digital world while affording schools and departments the latitude to construct tenure and promotion policies with the larger parameters of the campus.

Approval of Motions to Amend the Common Calendar

The Bloomington Faculty Council approved several changes to the deadlines by which enrollment verification rosters and grades should be submitted as well as recommended that all instructor actions be included in a single Student Performance roster under the FLAGS system. The passage of this resolution was made contingent upon the full functionality of the system and the office of the registrar was charged with communicating the achievement of this functionality when it is achieved.
