

Constitution of Digital Enterprise Club

The Digital Enterprise Systems Club is an organization at the Kelley School of Business, geared toward sparking interest in enterprise systems. We aim to organize events and activities that help graduate and undergraduate students at the Kelley School of Business learn more about how enterprises are running their operations using information systems. This covers topics like master data management, how businesses interact with their customers, how they manage & optimize their internal operations etc.

The DES club has an Executive Board which manages the daily operations of the student organization and a faculty sponsor from the Kelley School of Business to support the initiatives.

It will comply with following clauses as part of this constitution:

Article I: University Compliance

This organization shall comply with all Indiana University regulations, and local, state and federal laws.

Article II: Non-Hazing

Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.

Article III: Personal Gain Clause

This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.
