

# **Kelley Korean Finance Seminar Constitution**

## **ARTICLE I – Name**

- 1) The name of this organization shall be: Kelley Korean Finance Seminar (KKFS). This is a student organization at Indiana University Bloomington.

## **ARTICLE II – Objectives**

- 1) The objectives of this organization shall be:
  - Create awareness of financial securities industries to Indiana University students
  - Gain practical knowledge by weekly discussing the current business and finance issues
  - Provide opportunities to expose to various workshop and seminars
  - Develop essential skills and abilities to be a world-leading finance professional
  - Increase the placement of members into highly competitive positions in finance industry
  - Build up a strong, interactive relationship between members and coaches

## **ARTICLE III – Membership**

- 1) Any Korean undergraduate student at Indiana University who is interested in working in finance industries is eligible to apply for membership.
- 2) Officials will select qualified candidates through interview processes based on the following criteria and qualities:
  - Strong passion for finance industries
  - Appreciative loyalty to organization
  - Active involvement in organizational events
  - 3.0 cumulative grade point average
  - Able to participate for at least 1 academic year
  - Preferred majors: finance, accounting
- 3) Membership will be suspended or terminated upon the thorough review of organizational officers.

## **ARTICLE IV – Officers**

- 1) The officers of this organization are president, vice president, treasury, secretary and public relations manager.
- 2) Officers will be elected on a yearly basis and under the consideration of officers.
- 3) Election of officers will take place during the last week of every spring semester.

## **ARTICLE V – Not-for-profit organization**

- 1) This is a not-for-profit student organization.

#### **ARTICLE VI – Financial obligation**

- 1) Officers of this organization may determine reasonable dues and fees assessed to each member at the beginning of each semester.

#### **ARTICLE VII – Others**

- 1) **The Statement of Compliance with Indiana University Regulation:** This organization shall comply with all university and campus policies and regulations and local, state, federal laws.
- 2) **Anti-Hazing Policy:** Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.
- 3) **Personal Gain Clause:** This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation directly from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.
- 4) **Statement of Non-Discrimination:** Participation in the proposed organization must be without regard to arbitrary consideration of such characteristics as age, color, disability, ethnicity, gender, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
