

# **Constitution of Programmatik**

## **Preamble**

The goal of Programmatik is to foster a community for students aiming to gain traction in Silicon Valley and tech hubs. It primarily focuses on the technical interview aspect and networking for those experiencing or soon to experience.

## **Article I: Membership**

There are no limits to membership. So long as one has a mind willing to work and learn, one may join.

Members may be removed, including officers and president, by a vote of no confidence (60%) by members.

## **Article II: University Compliance**

This organization shall comply with all Indiana University regulations, and local, state and federal laws.

## **Article III: Executive Officers**

**President:** Holds and attends weekly meetings. Produces a question sheet. Acts as liaison between faculty and club.

**Vice President:** Serves as President provided President cannot attend. Spearheads travel, room bookings, and logistics.

**Secretary:** Re-registers the organization. Receives printed out question sheet.

All officers serve so long as they are voted in, annually. Duties begin two weeks before the end of the Spring semester and end (or resume upon re-election) two weeks before the end of the Spring semester.

#### **Article IV: Advisor**

The advisor acts as guidance provided the organization requires assistance in either dealings with the university or inner-conflict. Advisor may choose to continue or end their appointment at any time. The advisor(s) is selected from a pool of interested parties and then voted on.

#### **Article V: Meetings**

Programmatik holds weekly meetings, usually towards the end of the week. Meetings are advertised via SICE email listing, viral, flyers, and social media. Any officer has the authority to call and set the agenda for a meeting. Meetings will be ordered via floor motions. One person will be named chair and the chair has the authority to call on those to speak. Emergency meetings are held at the behest of officers and may be held electronically / remote.

#### **Article VI: Elections**

Elections are held annually, four weeks before the end of the semester.

An unlimited amount of people can be nominated and can be nominated through vocal nomination during any regular meeting.

Voting will be during the election meeting and will be open hands. Election will be reminded two weeks before election.

#### **Article VII: Non-Hazing**

Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.

#### **Article VIII: Dues & Budgets**

There are no dues.

### **Article IX: Finances**

The secretary is in charge of finances in the rare event that the club should require handling of money.

### **Article X: Personal Gain Clause**

This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.

### **Article XI: Amendments**

Amendments pass upon 60% of present members.
