



# CONSTITUTION

## Impact Movement

### Indiana University

#### **Article I: Name**

The name of this organization shall be The Impact Movement.

#### **Article II: Purpose**

Impact Movement is an interdenominational, student, Christian organization seeking to provide a spiritual resource for Indiana University students.

#### **Article III: Membership**

Membership is open to anyone who has an active interest in its activities. There are no "members" in the sense of meeting requirements or being officially accepted into membership. Impact Movement was formed by Christians who agree in their belief that man's only access to God is through Jesus Christ and faith in His deity, His death as full payment for man's sins, and His resurrection. While this is the foundational worldview of Impact Movement leadership, those holding other beliefs are welcome to attend Impact Movement's events, activities, and Bible studies.

#### **Article IV: Officers**

Impact Movement does not have officers. However, a group of participants with a strong commitment to the vision and purpose of the organization will be assembled each semester to serve as the core leadership of Impact Movement.

#### **Article V: Meetings**

Regular meetings will be held weekly for all who are interested. Special meetings may be called whenever necessary.

#### **Article VI: Advisor**

The Advisor for the Impact Movement is Tyler Kelley.

#### **Article VII: Committees**

Regular committees will be established and special committees will be set up as needed.

## **Article VIII: Statement of Compliance**

This organization shall comply with all Indiana University regulations, and local, state and federal laws.

## **Article IX: Anti-Hazing Policy**

Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.

## **Article X: Personal Gain Clause**

This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.
