

**IU KOKOMO STAFF COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2005-2006

Staff Council is open to all full-time and part-time appointed staff of the Kokomo Campus, consisting of about 91 members at present. This organization fosters the spirit of teamwork, cooperation: creativity and innovation toward the end of helping IU Kokomo become one of the state's best universities for employment and education.

A Web committee was formed to discuss content for the Council website.

In August the council paid half of the cost of a new tablecloth for orientation but can be used for other events. The total cost was \$312.

In September Student lockers and wheel chairs were purchased. Two wheelchairs for \$179 each and one was placed in the Kelley Center and the other in the Main Bldg.

In September we purchased 4X6 plexiglass for the university to advertise events the cost was 11 signs for \$150.

In September the Council donated \$1000 gift card to the Katrina disaster efforts. We contacted Bill Nunez who is now the Chancellor of LSU in Eunice.

An Archiving initiative was started to archive Staff Council records

In December a group of council members volunteered to wrap Christmas gifts for the Rescue Mission.

In February we raised \$69.84 for our Hacienda Day.

On February 11th a team of IU Staff council members walked for the "Walk a Mile in My shoes" fundraiser for the Kokomo Rescue Mission.

We sponsored \$250 for the children's activity booth at the Campus Renaissance Fair in April.

In May we bought water bottles and labeled them with Congratulation from Staff Council on your graduation.

Responsible for awarding \$1,000 in scholarships to one full time student and one part time student for the 2005-2006 academic year. In July we had a reception and met with the 05-06 recipients Mary Janna Mallay and Erik Pattison.
