# TSUNG YEH

Music Director

The 1992-93 Season will mark Tsung Yeh's fifth highly successful season as Music Director and Conductor of the South Bend Symphony.

In November 1991, Tsung Yeh successfully made his debut with the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, replacing the indisposed Daniel Barenboim on short notice in a program featuring Alfred Brendel as soloist. In his review John von Rhein of the Chicago Tribune called Yeh, "a musician to keep one's eye on."

Recently, Mr. Yeh was chosen to participate in a mentor program co-sponsored by the American Symphony Orchestra League and the Chicago Symphony Orchestra starting with its 1991-92 season. Maestro Yeh will work under the guidance of Music Director Barenboim in the full range of the orchestra's activities.

Critics were impressed with Mr. Yeh at the American Symphony Orchestra League American Conductors Program in June 1989. Hailed as the "most promising" of the three young conductors selected to perform with the San Francisco Symphony for the annual program, the Oakland Tribune declared, "He has an excellent ear for balance and coloration...no element dominated...an achievement for even the most seasoned conductor."
