The South Bend Youth Symphony is, in the true sense of the word, a unique organization. There is *no other orchestra* like it in the United States. The South Bend Youth Symphony, however, is the *only* all-city orchestra whose sole aim is to provide this age level (and not upper class high school musicians) with an opportunity to experience in public performance the grueling delights of excellent music.

The group has been recognized again and again for its astonishing dedication and musicianship. Perhaps more important than recognition in the long run, though, is the impact that Youth Symphony alumni are having on their communities. Like ripples in a pond, the influence of the fine musical training for young people is spreading outward, touching the lives of more and more people. The South Bend Community School Corporation and Indiana University South Bend are proud to be collaborators in such an important and successful effort.
