The committee met on April 28, 2004 at 9 am in 200 C Whitewater.

The committee was presented with a student petition for an exception to the extended grade replacement policy. The petition was denied. The same student appealed a grade that she earned in a distance education course that originated at IUPUI. The committee agreed that it is not in the purview of AAA to review grades earned at IUPUI.

The committee discussed further revision of the draft of the Admissions policy. Cathy pointed out that the admissions policy should be such that IU East is not de facto an open admissions college. The committee agreed to deny admissions to students who place in the low placement range in two or three areas. A similar restriction was made for students in the non-traditional category. The committee also discussed removing the stipulation that disallows students who were dismissed from other institutions to be admitted under faculty-sponsorship. The committee could not see a reason why the clause should stand but agreed to ask VCES for advice.

The committee agreed to prepare a summary of the current draft of the admissions policy for discussion during the senate meeting.

The committee adjourned at 10:30 am..
