The committee met on January 10, 2005 at 9:00 am in DAR to consider student's appeals of suspension. At the conclusion of the Fall semester, 61 students were suspended. 29 students appealed their suspension and two students petitioned for reinstatement after suspension.

In previous meetings and in meetings of a subcommittee, 15 student appeals and one petition for reinstatement were approved with some conditions.

In the Jan 10 meeting the full committee considered 14 appeals of suspension and one petition for reinstatement. Of these, the committee approved 8 appeals of suspension and one petition for reinstatement and denied six appeals of suspension.

The committee adjourned at 3:30 pm.

Addendum: January 15, 2004.

The committee had received three additional appeals or additional documentation that had not been available during the meeting on Jan. 10. The committee was convinced that the circumstances that lead to the delays were beyond the control of the students. The committee reconsidered two appeals and rescinded its earlier negative decisions. The committee approved a fourth appeal.

Addendum: January 26, 2004.

The committee received yet another appeal. The student was not notified of her suspension. The committee decided to grant the appeal with a reduced number of credit hours.
