

Many high school students cannot take the ACT or SAT because of cancellations related to the COVID-19 pandemic. For this reason, all of the IU regional campuses are moving to “test-waiver” admissions, at least temporarily. These temporary criteria would replace our current criteria and would be in place for students applying to begin at IU Kokomo in the fall. This criteria would remain in place until the Admissions Committee, Academic Affairs, and the Office of Admissions reconvene in fall 2020 to consider permanent criteria. (*Note that Admissions will need to use them for students applying to begin in spring 2021 and fall 2021 until we have permanent criteria.*)

The IU Kokomo Faculty Senate Admissions Committee fully support the temporary adoption of the Test Waiver Policy below.

Waive the requirement of a test score and employ strictly a GPA standard for both students who opt in or opt out of submitting test scores:

Fully Qualified Admit: High School GPA ≥ 2.3

Conditional Admit: $2.0 \leq$ High School GPA ≤ 2.29 - This population will be offered admission contingent on completing the Key Summer Institute or equivalent student success program.
