ROBIN HOOD

The legend of Robin Hood is a tale of how Robin Hood and his friends from Sherwood Forest stand up against the evil Sheriff of Nottingham, who has been taking money from the poor people. The sheriff plans to capture Robin by sponsoring an archery contest at his fair. He believes that Robin's enormous pride will not allow another archer to be named the finest in the kingdom.

The play begins with Robin and his men meeting the sheriff's knight, who has taken money from a poor widow. When the widow arrives, Robin allows her to take the money back from the knight to pay her debt to the sheriff.

Wearing an eye patch to disguise himself, Robin competes in the pompous sheriff's archery contest. He defeats Sir Guy, the sheriff's representative, to win a golden arrow.

While Robin and his friends are celebrating the victory, Marian, a young lady of Nottingham, and Midge, her servant, appear in disguise. When the sheriff and his men arrive, they abduct Marian and Will, another of Robin's friends.

Marian is guarded by the sheriff's daughter. He plans to hang Will, whom he has mistaken for Robin Hood. When Will asks for a sword to fight for his life, Little John, Robin's ally, arrives and hands Will the sheriff's sword. Four of the sheriff's men fight Robin and his troupe. Robin and his men are victorious. The sheriff's men are chased away as Robin and Marian are reunited.

Robin Hood, his friends, and the sheriff gather at the widow's home for a feast so the sheriff can see that the widow, from whom he had stolen money, is happy and living comfortably. Since deer are protected in Nottingham Forest, Robin's men, in jest, dress the sheriff in a deer costume so that he is assured protection as he returns home.

King Richard appears and bestows knighthood on Robin because Robin has followed the Law of the Forest: "Be always just, honest, and fair." Before King Richard departs, he unites Robin and Marian in marriage.
