The Faculty Senate Nominating Committee communicated via e-mail and held no meetings this past academic year.

Summary of Activities:

In late February the previous chair, Peter Tupa, sent an e-mail to all committee members including relevant files and major tasks that would need to be completed prior to the March 2021 Faculty Senate Meeting (Appendix A). Given Peter’s role as faculty senate secretary, a new chair of the nominating committee was needed, and Amy Salmeto-Johnson accepted Yusuf’s nomination to serve in this role. In early March, an e-mail requesting nomination for open Faculty Senate and Board of Review positions was sent by the Faculty Senate president, Paul Cook, on behalf of the committee chair (Appendix B). During the March 2021 Faculty Senate meeting all open positions were filled (Appendix C).
