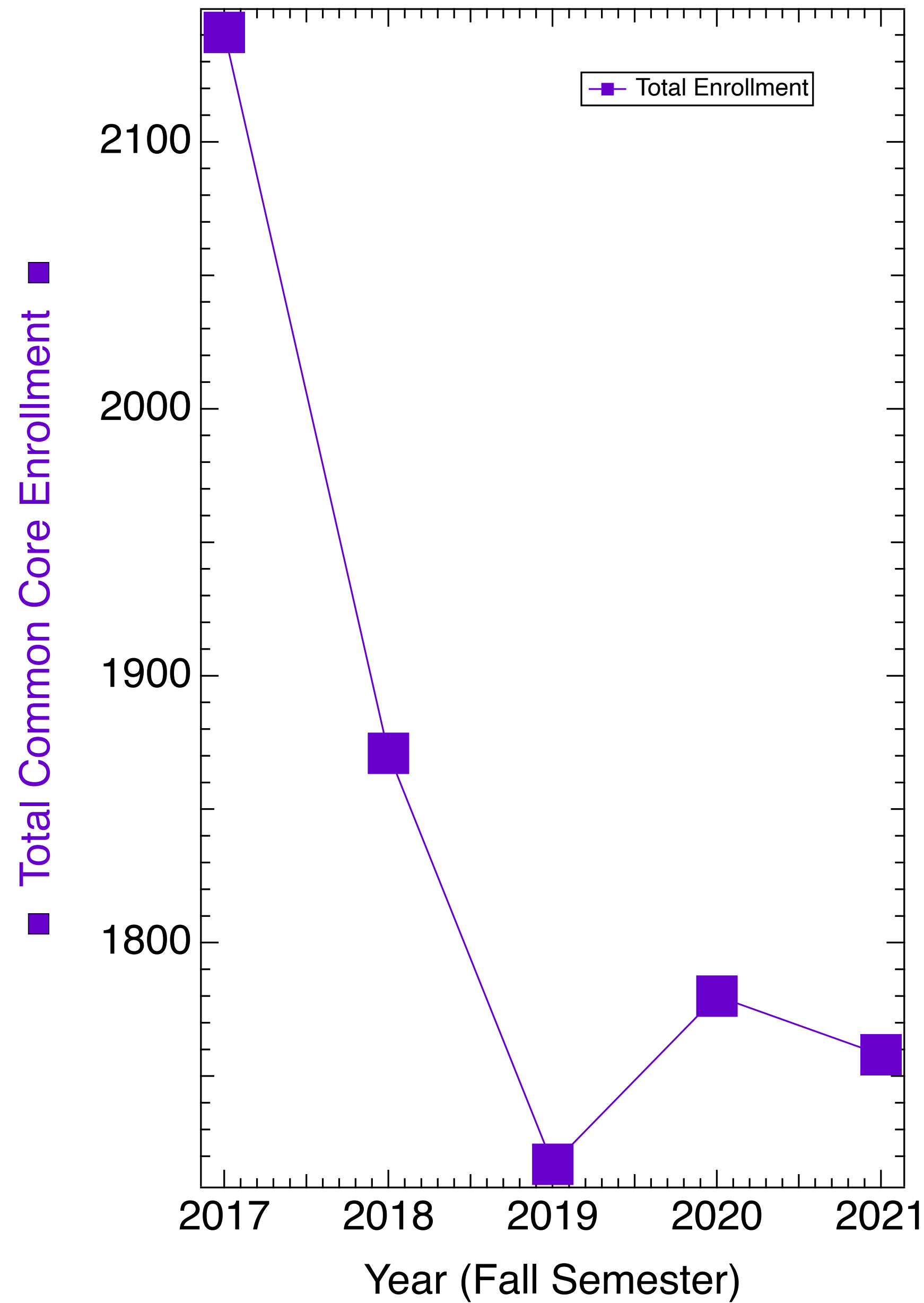
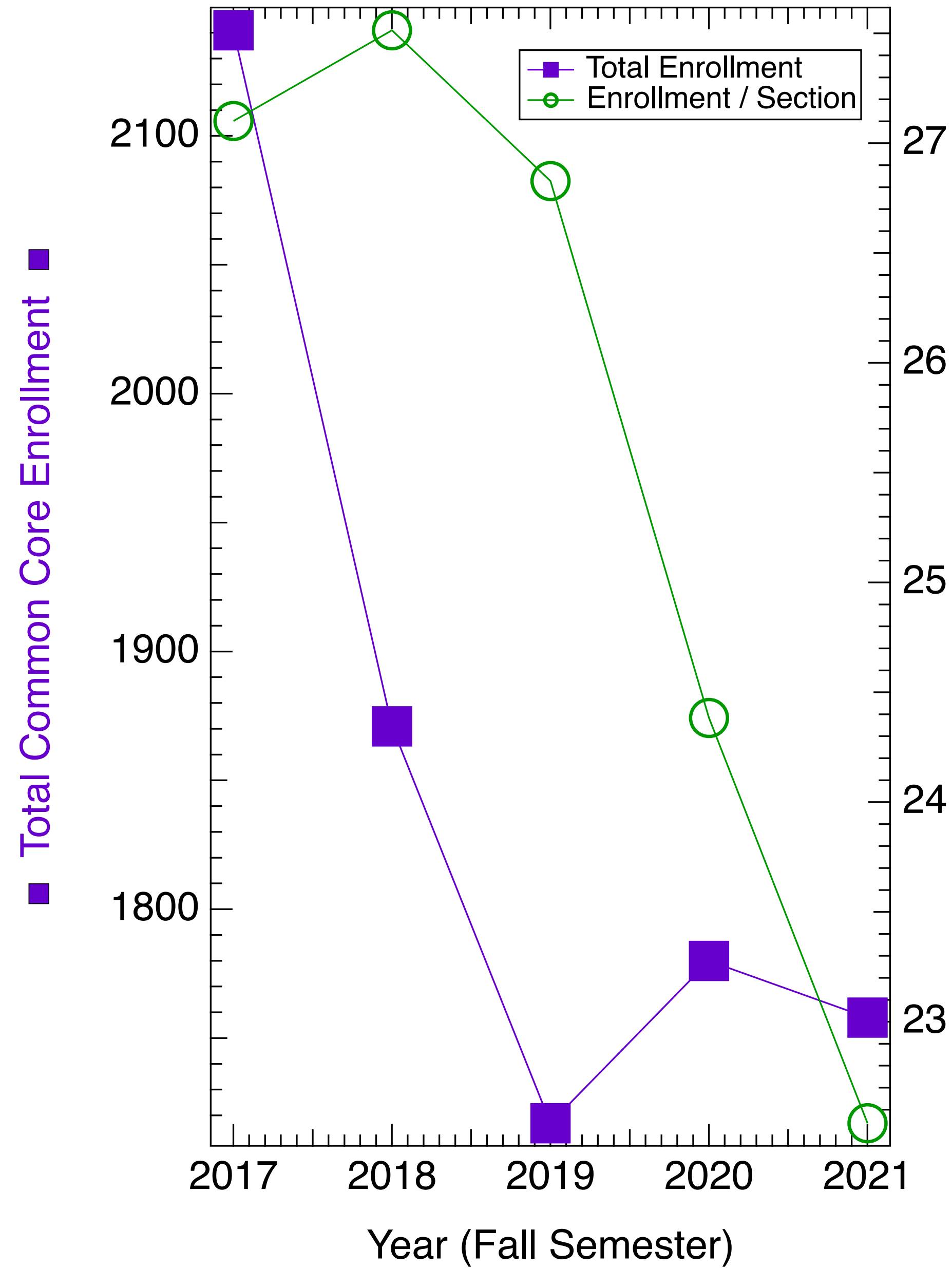


Five-Year Trends in Common Core Enrollments

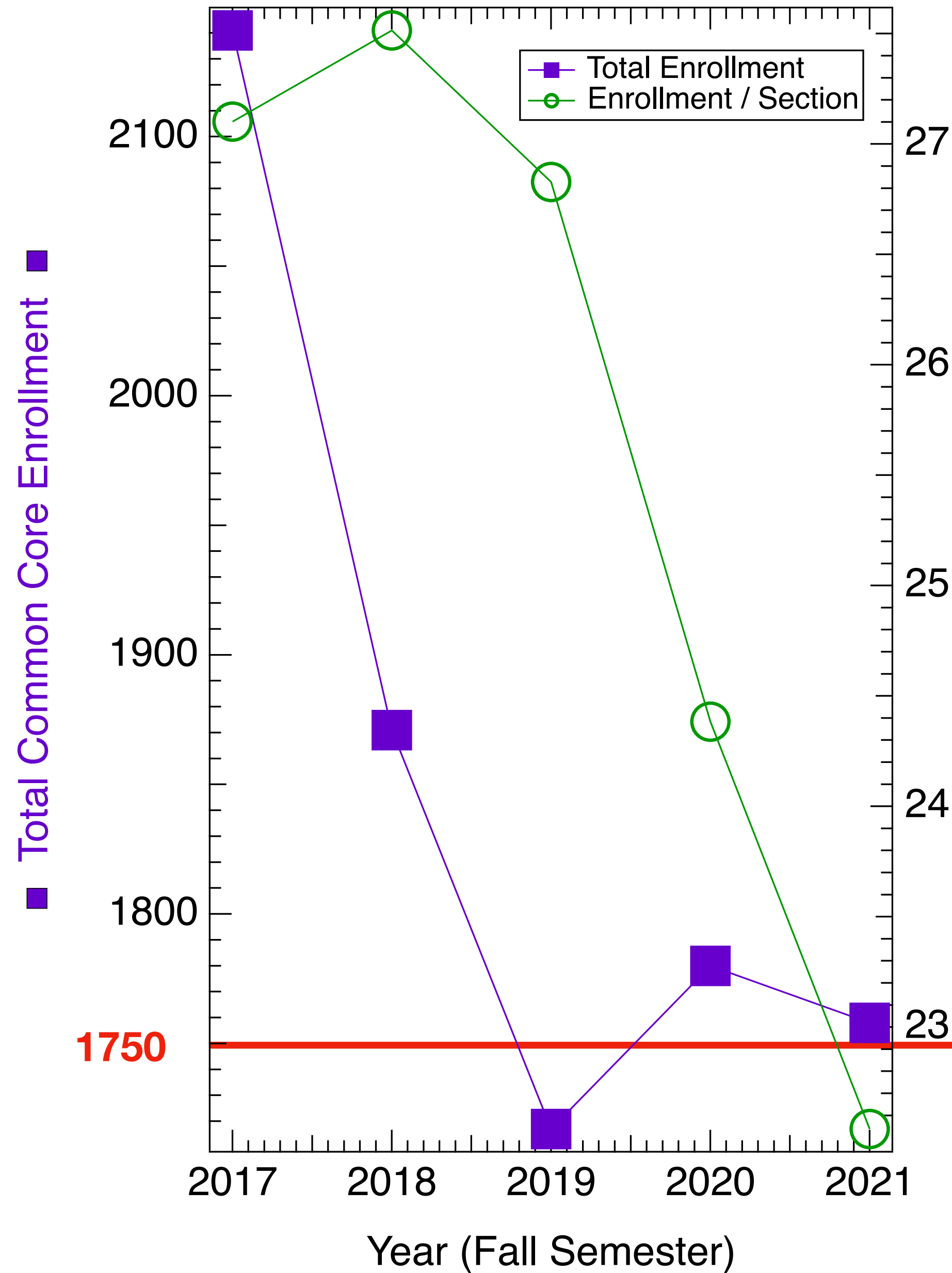

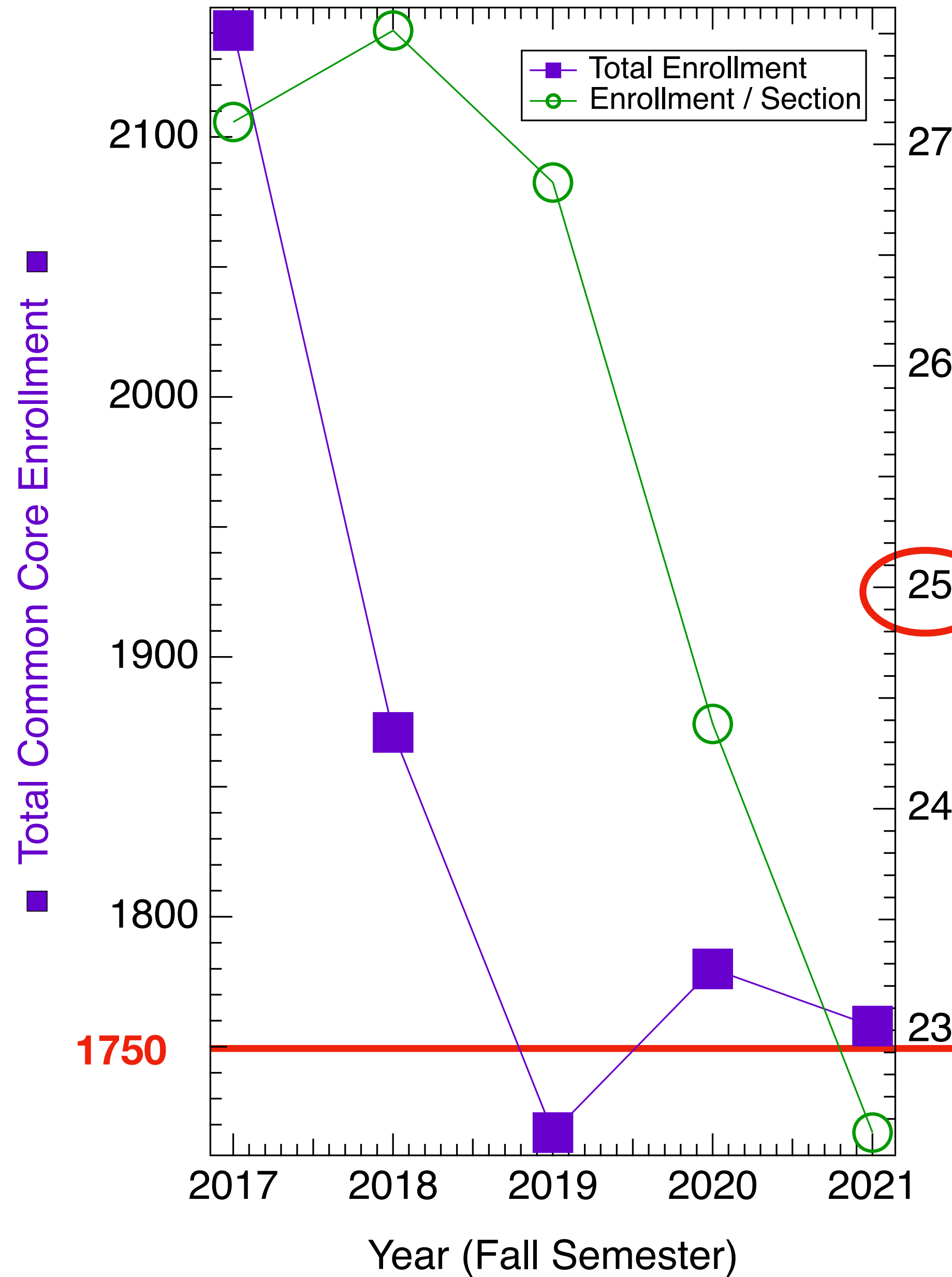

Average of 25 enrolled / section would imply 70 sections — a reduction of 10 sections compared to Fall 2021

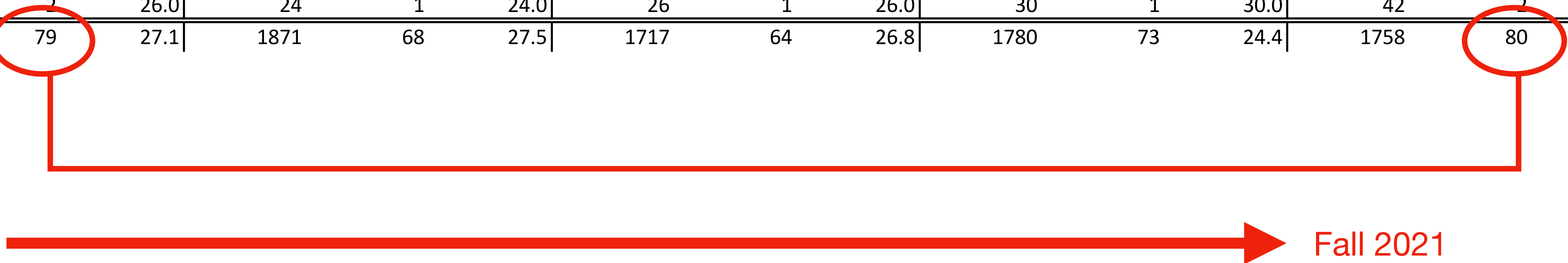

Try moving back toward the left by reducing sections

- Don't appear to need a drastic reduction (~10 relative to last fall)
- Balance unit needs with effort to improve efficiency
- Move toward campus-wide scheduling collaboration
