# INDIANA UNIVERSITY KOKOMO

## ADMISSIONS STANDARDS

Thank you for applying to Indiana University Kokomo. In order to ensure that admitted students are prepared to be successful, each candidate for admission is considered on an individual basis. Completed applications should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the start of the term.

Please refer to the admissions status options below. You will select one when completing the application.

### FIRST YEAR APPLICANT

If you have not attended another college or university after completing high school or earning a GED, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + Official high school transcript or GED scores
- + Test scores are optional for admission but required for scholarship consideration.
- + If you earned college credit while in high school, please submit an official transcript from each college or university attended

### TRANSFER APPLICANT

If you have attempted 12 college credits at another college or university, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + Official transcript from each college or university attended
- + Official high school transcript or GED scores if you have attempted less than 12 college level credit hours

### VISITING/GUEST STUDENT APPLICANT

If you are attending another college or university and wish to attend IU Kokomo for one semester or summer session and return to your home institution, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + Transcript from your home institution showing grades from your most recent semester

### SECOND DEGREE APPLICANT

If you have earned a bachelor's degree and wish to earn another bachelor's degree, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + Official transcript from each college or university attended

### UNDERGRADUATE NON-DEGREE APPLICANT

If you have earned a high school diploma, GED or some college credits and do not plan to seek a degree at this time, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + If you have no college experience, submit official high school transcript or GED scores
- + If you have earned any college-level credit hours, submit a transcript from the last college or university attended
- + Financial aid is not available

### GRADUATE NON-DEGREE APPLICANT

If you have previously earned a bachelor's degree and do not wish to seek a degree at this time, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Graduate Admission
- + Official transcript showing the undergraduate degree you were awarded
- + Financial aid is not available

### SPECIAL HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANT

If you have completed your junior year of high school and wish to enroll in a course on campus, you must submit the following materials:

- + Application for Undergraduate Admission
- + Official high school transcript showing coursework
- + A copy of your PSAT, SAT or ACT scores
- + Letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor
- + Financial Aid is not available
