



This report summarizes the data submitted to IPEDS with the Graduation Rates Survey. The cohort is defined as full-time beginner (FTB), degree-seeking students who matriculated in either of the preceding summer sessions or in the fall of 1997, or students who began their coursework in high school and enrolled as traditional college students in the fall. A total of fifteen students are excluded from the original cohort for reasons of military service (3) or death (12).

The first table below shows the overall graduation rates for the 1996 and 1997 cohorts. These rates combine all degree-seeking students and provide the number of students who earned their degree within 150% of program length. As the percent change indicates, six of the eight campuses have improved on this rate over the previous cohort. The second table provides a view of graduation rates limited to students seeking and receiving bachelor's degrees for the 1996 and 1997 cohorts. Because of guidelines provided by various higher education groups, these are the figures that are published externally. Finally, the last table on this page explores the composition of the 1997 beginner cohort. These figures illustrate the diversity of students served by the IU campuses, and by extension, the representativeness of the graduation rates measure as it only involves full-time students.

The campus specific pages provide similar breakdowns of the FTB students by the type of degree intended and earned, the composition of the cohort, and the overall graduation rate by a variety of incoming and demographic characteristics.
