



This report provides views on persistence to the second semester for the incoming full-time, beginner cohorts of 2000, 2001, and 2002. Consistent with our cohort logic, students are defined to a cohort based upon their entry semester/status (fall or either previous summer session/degree-seeking beginner or transfer) and/or by their high school graduation date when appropriate.

An appendix (12.2.1) is available which provides views on the entire beginner cohorts and part-time beginner cohort subsets. This and other reports are available via our website at <http://www.indiana.edu/~urr>.

As part of accepted practice in retention reporting, deceased students are now excluded from the cohort figures. To protect student privacy, cells with a "began" number of ten or less are masked.

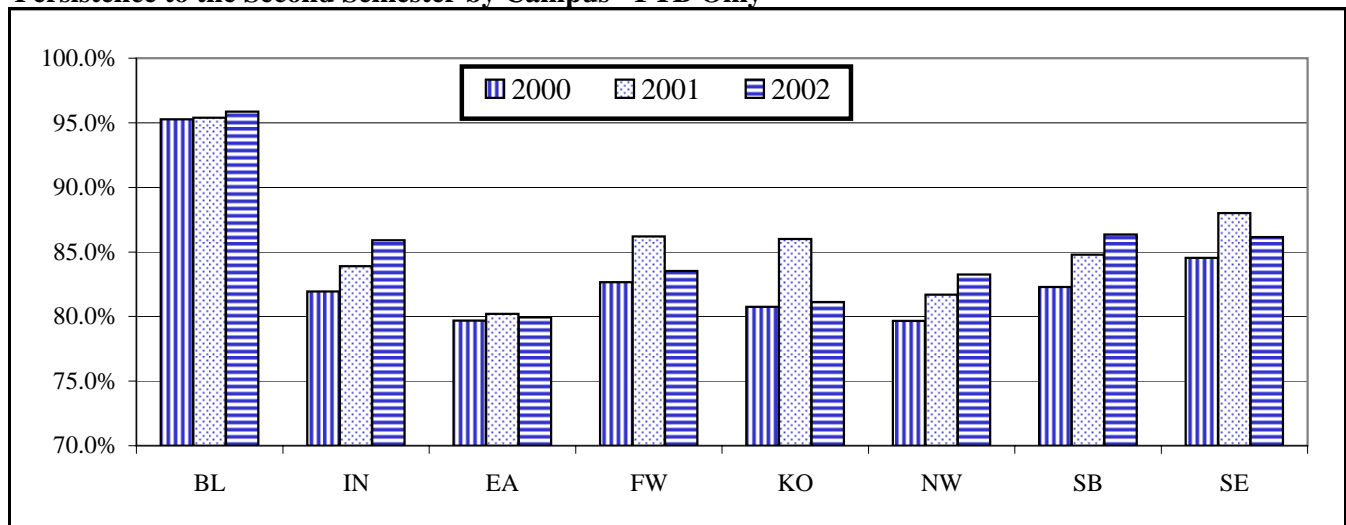
