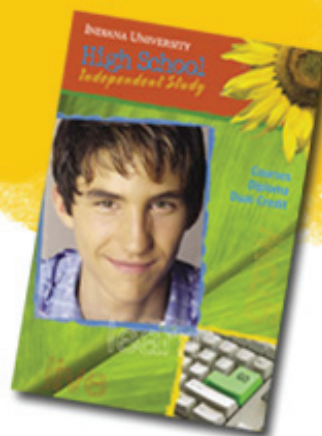

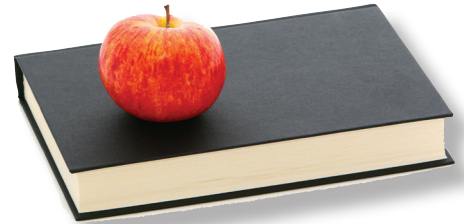

New Online Dual-Credit Math Course

Get a head start on college with M118w Finite Mathematics, IUHS's first online dual-credit math course.

As a student in the course, you will study basic probabilities, matrices, and linear programming. To register, you must have completed two years of high school algebra.

With dual credit, you earn both high school and college credit, get a head start on your college degree (and save money!), get a feel for college-level course work, and gain access to one of the country's top research universities.

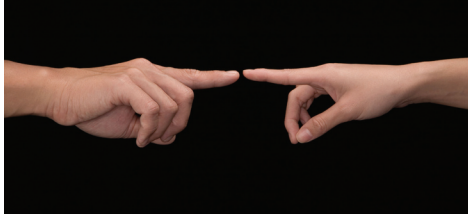
