

List of Courses Approved by the General Education Curriculum Committee, Spring 2009

Item number 3 of “The General Education Committee and Campus Charge” in BFC Circular 30-2007 stipulates that “In order for any proposal to be approved by the committee, whether concerning course recommendations or broader matters, the proposal must receive the support both (i) of a majority of the voting members and (ii) of at least some voting members from at least four of the College and Schools. Only a majority vote of the committee is necessary to disapprove any such proposal.” On April 15 the full General Education Committee voted to endorse the following list of courses recommended by the Common Ground Committees.

Endorsement of the list means these courses will become part of the new curriculum. Additional courses will be added in the future by the General Education Curriculum Committee. In fact, the process of requesting and vetting course proposals will occur annually, with Round 4 currently scheduled for Spring 2010.

This list includes 719 courses recommended unconditionally by the Common Ground Committees which vetted course proposals. Reviews for 8 other courses are still underway, as committees seek additional information about course content and pedagogy; this information is needed in order to determine if proposed courses satisfy the relevant rubrics. In a few cases there are unresolved issues of compliance with policies enacted by the General Education Curriculum Committee concerning frequency of offering, course numbering, and variable titles. Action by the full committee on these 8 courses is therefore deferred until have been recommended by the Common Ground Committees.

Some 586 course proposals were not approved by Common Ground Committees because they did not fulfill the relevant rubrics. The co-chairs of the General Education Curriculum Committee will notify the chief academic officer of the College or School that proposed a course that was not approved. The notice will explain why approval was withheld. The notice will invite the College or School to revise and resubmit proposals for the courses in question, should it choose to do so.
