Statement of Purpose:


The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding between Indiana University Kokomo (IUK) and Ivy Tech State College Region 5 is to provide for the articulation of two Ivy Tech State College Region 5 Associate of Science degrees in Accounting and Business Administration with two IUK Bachelor of Science degrees: Accounting, and Management and Administration.


The attached curriculum outlines demonstrate the relationship of individual courses and indicate course numbers, titles, credit hours, and prerequisites. Students wishing to major in accounting are strongly encouraged to take the following Ivy Tech accounting courses: Acc 101 Accounting Principles I, Acc 102 Accounting Principles II, Acc 203 Cost Accounting I, and Acc 204 Cost Accounting II, or to repeat A201 Introduction to Accounting at IUK before taking A311 Intermediate Accounting Theory and Principles I.


Students wishing to transfer individual courses (short of an associate's degree) from Ivy Tech State College will be required to apply two Ivy Tech State College accounting courses for each IUK accounting course. Moreover, students transferring individual courses should understand that micro economics taken at Ivy Tech State College will not be accepted for transfer.


This articulation agreement is effective for students completing either the Associate of Science degree in Accounting or the Associate of Science degree in Business Administration at Ivy Tech State College in December 1997 and thereafter. Students graduating in these programs prior to December 1997 will fall under previous course by course transfer agreements.


