
LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, WE CONTINUE TONIGHT AN ANCIENT TRADITION OF ASSEMBLING IN FORMAL CONVOCATION TO RECOGNIZE THOSE WHO HAVE ACHIEVED A SIGNIFICANT MILESTONE ON THE ROAD TO KNOWLEDGE AND SELF-REALIZATION.

1. ON SUCH AN OCCASION, WE RECOGNIZE FIRST THESE STUDENTS WHOSE SUCCESSFUL RESPONSE TO THEIR EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE HAS WON FOR THEM THE AWARDING OF A DEGREE.

(MS. LOZIER HANDS SCROLL TO MR. DANIELSON, WHO STEPS FORWARD TO RECEIVE IT.)

MS. LOZIER CONTINUES:

THANK YOU, SAB^RAINA. PRESIDENT BATMAN, THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY PRESENT TO YOU FOR ADMISSION INTO THE BODY OF ALUMNI THESE CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES, MEMBERS OF THE CLASS OF 1980. THEY HAVE DEMONSTRATED THEIR PERSONAL AND ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE UNIVERSITY'S FAMILY OF ALUMNI.

PRESIDENT RYAN:

WE COME NOW TO THE CLIMAX OF THESE CEREMONIES, THE CONFERRING OF YOUR DEGREES.

YOU WILL OBSERVE THAT CANDIDATES WHO HAVE BEEN TENTATIVELY AWARDED HONORS IN GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP ARE DISTINGUISHED BY CREAM AND CRIMSON FOURRAGERES, WHICH ARE CORDS WORN ON THE LEFT SHOULDER. THOSE WITH CREAM AND CRIMSON FOURRAGERES INDICATE HIGHEST DISTINCTION. HIGH DISTINCTION IS REPRESENTED BY THOSE WITH ALL CREAM FOURRAGERES. DISTINCTION IS RECOGNIZED BY CRIMSON FOURRAGERES. THE UNIVERSITY IS PROUD OF ALL HER STUDENTS AND TAKES AN ADDED MEASURE OF PRIDE IN THOSE WHO HAVE EXCELLED ACADEMICALLY. WILL THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH HIGHEST DISTINCTION PLEASE STAND. ASSUME THIS ROLE AS AN OPPORTUNITY AND FULFILL YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES IN A CONSCIENTIOUS MANNER.

YOU ARE TO BE COMPLIMENTED ON HAVING SOUGHT BREADTH OF UNDERSTANDING; AND YOU ARE ASKED TO WEIGH THE IMPORTANCE OF SEEKING ADVANCED OR PROFESSIONAL PREPARATION. WE BID YOU GO FORTH TO YOUR CHALLENGES, TO YOUR DESTINY, MAINTAINING YOUR HABITS OF STUDY AND OF OBJECTIVE THOUGHT THROUGHOUT YOUR LIVES, AND TO CONTRIBUTE THE BEST THAT IS IN YOU TO EVERY WORTHY ENDEAVOR THAT YOU UNDERTAKE.

PRESIDENT RYAN:

CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES FROM THE DIVISION OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS,
THIS NATION'S HIGH STANDARD OF LIVING IS TO A GREAT EXTENT
ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE EFFICIENCY OF OUR ECONOMIC AND INDUSTRIAL
ENTERPRISE. YOU HAVE BEEN TRAINED FOR POSITIONS OF SERVICE
AND EVENTUAL LEADERSHIP IN THESE FIELDS. SOME OF YOU MAY
PURSUE FURTHER FORMAL STUDY WITH A VIEW TO TEACHING AND RESEARCH,
OR TO SEEKING HIGHER LEVELS OF COMPETENCE FOR EMPLOYMENT.


