Faculty Marshals indicate to the candidates they should stand.  
The Platform Party members walk to their chairs and remain  
standing. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to the side microphone.)

GRAND MARSHAL FARIS:    **PRESIDENT EHRLICH,  
CHANCELLOR COHEN, THE CANDIDATES ARE  
ASSEMBLED.   ► WE MAY NOW PROCEED WITH  
THESE COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES.**

(The GRAND MARSHAL peaks his cap. The PRESIDENT and CHANCELLOR COHEN return the gesture. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to his chair and remains standing. The PRESIDENT moves to the lectern microphone.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, AS WE BEGIN THIS COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY, WE WILL BE LED IN THE SINGING OF THE NATIONAL ANTHEM BY DR. ROBERT W. DEMAREE, JR., (*Dem-aree*) CHAIRMAN AND PROFESSOR OF MUSIC. ► DR. GLENN F. CHESNUT (*Chez-nut*), PROFESSOR OF HISTORY, WILL OFFER THE INVOCATION. ► (If audience is seated.) PLEASE STAND.**

(The PRESIDENT returns to seat, doffs cap, and remains standing.)

(All doff caps.)

(NATIONAL ANTHEM

(INVOCATION

DR. CHESNUT)

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH steps to the lectern.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: PLEASE BE SEATED. ► LADIES  
AND GENTLEMEN, MEMBERS OF THE CLASS OF 1988,  
IT IS MY HAPPY PRIVILEGE TO WELCOME YOU TO THE  
159TH ANNUAL COMMENCEMENT CEREMONIES OF  
INDIANA UNIVERSITY AND THE TWENTY-SECOND  
COMMENCEMENT EXERCISE ON THIS CAMPUS.  
► ESPECIALLY I WELCOME THE PARENTS, WIVES,  
HUSBANDS, AND OTHER RELATIVES WHO HAVE  
HELPED MAKE POSSIBLE THIS DAY OF ACHIEVEMENT  
FOR OUR CANDIDATES AND WHO SHARE THEIR PRIDE  
IN THIS CELEBRATION OF ACCOMPLISHMENT.  
WE CONTINUE TONIGHT AN HONORED TRADITION OF  
ASSEMBLING IN FORMAL CONVOCATION TO  
RECOGNIZE THE STUDENTS WHOSE SUCCESS IN THEIR  
EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE HAS EARNED THEM A  
DEGREE.**

**INDIANA UNIVERSITY IS PROUD OF HER HISTORY. ► WE  
ARE PROUD TO BE THE STATE UNIVERSITY,  
SUPPORTED BY THE PEOPLE OF INDIANA AND  
DEDICATED TO THEIR EDUCATION AND TO ENHANCING  
OUR STATE, OUR COUNTRY, AND ALL THE WORLD.**

**NOW, I AM PLEASED TO INTRODUCE DANIEL COHEN,  
CHANCELLOR OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY AT SOUTH  
BEND. ► CHANCELLOR COHEN.**

(CHANCELLOR COHEN rises, peaks cap, and moves to lectern.  
PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and resumes seat.)

**CHANCELLOR COHEN: THANK YOU, PRESIDENT EHRLICH.**

**► IT IS MY GREAT PLEASURE TO GREET OUR  
HONORED GUESTS AND TO EXTEND A WARM  
WELCOME TO ALL WHO ARE WITH US THIS EVENING,  
ESPECIALLY THE GRADUATES OF THE 22ND  
GRADUATING CLASS OF IUSB, AND THEIR FAMILIES  
AND FRIENDS.**

**SEATED ON THE PLATFORM ARE TRUSTEES,  
DISTINGUISHED OFFICERS OF THE UNIVERSITY,  
MEMBERS OF THE IUSB BOARD OF ADVISORS, AND  
OTHER SPECIAL GUESTS. ► YOU WILL FIND THE  
NAMES OF THESE PERSONS LISTED IN YOUR PRINTED  
PROGRAM. ► WE THANK THEM FOR THEIR  
PRESENCE AND THEIR PARTICIPATION IN OUR  
COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY.**

**THERE IS ONE PERSON, HOWEVER, ON THE PLATFORM  
WHOM I WISH TO INTRODUCE TO YOU NOW, AND I ASK  
THAT HE STAND TO RECEIVE OUR GREETING: THE  
DISTINGUISHED CHANCELLOR OF THE UNIVERSITY  
AND PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF BUSINESS  
ADMINISTRATION, DR. HERMAN B WELLS.**

**(CHANCELLOR leads applause, and resumes seat.)**

**(ALUMNI INDUCTION CEREMONY)**

**(PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to lectern.)**

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: WE WILL NOW OBSERVE THE  
TRADITIONAL CEREMONIES INDUCTING THE MEMBERS  
OF THE GRADUATING CLASSES INTO THEIR  
RESPECTIVE ALUMNI ASSOCIATIONS.**

**I INVITE MRS. GAY L. TOTTEN, DIRECTOR OF  
COMMUNICATIONS OF THE PURDUE ALUMNI  
ASSOCIATION, TO INDUCT THE PURDUE CANDIDATES.**

(MRS. TOTTEN rises, peaks cap, and moves to the lectern.)

PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and resumes seat.)

**MRS. TOTTEN: WILL THE PURDUE CANDIDATES PLEASE  
STAND. ► ON BEHALF OF THE MORE THAN 230,000  
PURDUE ALUMNI THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, PLEASE  
ACCEPT MY SINCERE CONGRATULATIONS ON THE  
COMPLETION OF AN IMPORTANT PART OF YOUR  
FORMAL EDUCATION. ► AS YOU TAKE YOUR PLACE  
AMONG US, WE INVITE YOU TO SHARE OUR PRIDE IN  
PURDUE, IN HER HERITAGE, AND IN HER FUTURE.**

**AS YOU RECEIVE YOUR DEGREES, YOU BECOME PART OF  
A PROUD TRADITION. ► YOU WILL FIND THAT YOUR  
PURDUE EDUCATION IS WELL RESPECTED AND THAT  
IT OPENS DOORS TO OPPORTUNITY FOR YOU.**

**► YOUR UNIVERSITY IS KNOWN FOR ITS EXCELLENCE,  
FOR THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF ITS ALUMNI, AND FOR ITS  
SERVICE TO MANKIND. ► FROM THE VASTNESS OF  
SPACE TO THE INFINITESIMAL INNER WORKINGS OF  
THE CELL, THE QUEST FOR KNOWLEDGE BEGUN BY A  
PURDUE EDUCATION IS VAST AND WORLD-SHAKING.**

**► PURDUE ALUMNI ARE LEADERS, THEY ASPIRE TO

ALSO IS EXCELLENCE, AND YOU ARE NOW A PART OF

(MRS. TOTTEN resumes seat. PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to the lectern.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: THE INDUCTION OF THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988 INTO THE WORLD-WIDE INDIANA UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION WILL BE LED BY MR. RICHARD B. STONER, B.S. 1941, OF COLUMBUS, PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, REPRESENTING THE UNIVERSITY. ► MR. THOMAS M. MITCHELL OF BLOOMINGTON, PRESIDENT-ELECT OF THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, WILL REPRESENT THE ALUMNI. ► MISS SANDRA A. HOLDERMAN, PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT ALUMNI COUNCIL ON THIS CAMPUS, WILL REPRESENT THE CANDIDATES.**

**ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE GRADUATING CLASS PLEASE STAND AND REMAIN STANDING UNTIL AFTER THE SINGING OF THE ALMA MATER SONG, "HAIL TO OLD I.U."**

(MR. STONER, MR. MITCHELL and MISS HOLDERMAN stand and peak caps. PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns gesture and resumes seat.)

MISS HOLDERMAN (addressing MR. STONER): **TRUSTEE STONER, INSCRIBED UPON THIS SCROLL ARE THE NAMES OF EVERY MEMBER OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988. ► I REQUEST THAT EACH NAME BE FORMALLY ADDED TO THE LIST OF ALUMNI OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY.**

(MISS HOLDERMAN hands scroll to MR. STONER, who steps forward to receive it.)

MISS HOLDERMAN continues: **WE PLEDGE OUR CONTINUING ALLEGIANCE AND ASK THE ALUMNI BODY TO DIRECT OUR SERVICE.**

MR. STONER: **THANK YOU, SANDRA.** (addressing MR. MITCHELL): **PRESIDENT-ELECT MITCHELL, THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY PRESENT TO YOU**

**FOR ADMISSION INTO THE BODY OF ALUMNI THESE CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES, MEMBERS OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988. ► THESE MEN AND WOMEN WILL BE THE UNIVERSITY'S REPRESENTATIVES IN MANY FIELDS OF ENDEAVOR THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. ► WE HOPE THAT THEIR WORK WILL REFLECT HONOR UPON AND BRING GREATER STRENGTH TO THE UNIVERSITY THEY REPRESENT.**

(MR. STONER hands scroll to MR. MITCHELL, who steps forward to receive it.)

**MR. MITCHELL (addressing MR. STONER): TRUSTEE STONER, WE ACCEPT INTO THE FELLOWSHIP OF ALUMNI THESE CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES FROM INDIANA UNIVERSITY.**

**MR. MITCHELL (addressing the candidates): MEMBERS OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988, WE WELCOME YOU**

**TO THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND WE WISH YOU  
WELL. ► THE STRENGTH OF THE ASSOCIATION AND  
THIS UNIVERSITY DEPENDS ON THE STRENGTH OF  
EACH OF YOU.**

**THE ALUMNI JOIN YOU IN YOUR PLEDGE OF SUPPORT FOR  
A UNIVERSITY COMMITTED TO GREATER SERVICE TO  
HUMANKIND.**

(IU representatives return to their seats and remain standing, and  
PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to the lectern.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: TO THE NEWEST INDIANA  
UNIVERSITY ALUMNI, I OFFER CONGRATULATIONS ON  
YOUR INDUCTION INTO THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY  
ALUMNI ASSOCIATION. ► WELCOME ABOARD.**

**IN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF YOUR INDUCTION INTO THE  
ALUMNI, FAMILY, I ASK DR. ROBERT W. DEMAREE, JR.,  
(Dem-aree) TO LEAD US ALL IN SINGING THE ALMA  
MATER SONG, "HAIL TO OLD I.U." ► THE WORDS**

**ARE ON PAGE 2 OF YOUR PROGRAM. ► WILL THE  
AUDIENCE PLEASE STAND.**

(All rise and doff caps.)

(DR. DEMAREE directs "Hail to Old I.U.," afterwards motioning the audience to resume their seats. PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to lectern.)

(CONFERRAL OF HONORARY DEGREE)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: PLEASE BE SEATED. ► A**

**SOLEMN TRADITION OF OUR COMMENCEMENT**

**CEREMONY IS THE AWARDING OF AN HONORARY**

**DEGREE. ► THE PERSON WHOM WE NOW**

**RECOGNIZE HAS STRONG TIES TO INDIANA**

(DEAN HARRIMAN rises and peaks cap. PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture. DEAN HARRIMAN escorts CHANCELLOR EMERITUS WOLFSON to the lectern. DEAN HARRIMAN stands at the side microphone. CHANCELLOR EMERITUS WOLFSON is between DEAN HARRIMAN and the PRESIDENT. CHANCELLOR EMERITUS WOLFSON removes his cap.)

DEAN HARRIMAN (partially facing the PRESIDENT): **MR.**

**► DURING HIS LONG AND PRODUCTIVE TENURE AS  
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, FROM 1964 TO 1987,  
THE SOUTH BEND CAMPUS BECAME THE LARGEST OF  
INDIANA UNIVERSITY'S REGIONAL CAMPUSES IN**

**TERMS OF ENROLLMENT OF IU STUDENTS, AND A VITAL FORCE FOR THE EDUCATIONAL, ECONOMIC, SOCIAL, AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE MICHIANA REGION. ► THE VALUE THAT HE PLACED ON A LIBERAL ARTS FOUNDATION IN ALL FIELDS OF HIGHER EDUCATION PROFOUNDLY INFLUENCED THE CHARACTER AND THE QUALITY OF THIS INSTITUTION.**

**► HIS ACHIEVEMENTS HERE WERE ALWAYS CARRIED OUT WITH COMMITMENT TO THE HIGHEST VALUES OF EDUCATION AND WITH OUTSTANDING ABILITY TO MEET THE PRACTICAL DEMANDS FACING EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.**

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: LESTER M. WOLFSON, WHAT YOU BUILT HERE IS LASTING, AND THE VALUES AND LIVELY**



**SPIRIT THAT YOU INFUSED INTO THIS CAMPUS ARE  
THE HEART OF ITS EXCELLENCE.**

**BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE  
TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY, I AM PROUD TO  
CONFER UPON YOU THE DEGREE DOCTOR OF HUMANE  
LETTERS, *HONORIS CAUSA*, WITH ALL THE RIGHTS AND  
PRIVILEGES APPERTAINING THERETO.**

(MR. BURTON hands the diploma to PRESIDENT EHRLICH.

PRESIDENT EHRLICH hands the diploma to CHANCELLOR  
EMERITUS WOLFSON. DR. FARIS hoods him. The PRESIDENT  
shakes hands with CHANCELLOR EMERITUS WOLFSON. DEAN  
HARRIMAN escorts CHANCELLOR EMERITUS WOLFSON to his  
seat and returns to his own seat.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, PLEASE  
JOIN ME IN EXPRESSING OUR CONGRATULATIONS TO  
THE RECIPIENT OF AN HONORARY DEGREE.**

(PRESIDENT leads applause.)

(PRESENTATION OF GRADUATING CLASS)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: IT IS NOW MY PLEASURE TO CALL  
ON CHANCELLOR COHEN TO PRESENT THE  
GRADUATING CLASS. ► CHANCELLOR COHEN.**

(CHANCELLOR COHEN rises, peaks cap, and moves to the  
lectern. PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and resumes  
seat.)

(PRESENTATION OF CLASS                      CHANCELLOR COHEN)

(CHANCELLOR COHEN resumes seat.)

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns to the lectern and doffs cap.)

(CHARGE TO THE CLASS)

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH dons cap and resumes seat.

CHANCELLOR COHEN returns to lectern.)

(CONFERRAL OF PURDUE DEGREES)

CHANCELLOR COHEN: **WE NOW COME TO THE CENTRAL  
MOMENT OF THESE CEREMONIES, THE CONFERRAL OF  
DEGREES. ► I AM PLEASED TO CALL ON DR. DON K.  
GENTRY, DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY OF  
PURDUE UNIVERSITY, TO CONFER THE PURDUE  
DEGREES. ► MR. WAYNE BARKER AND DR. KARL  
PERUSICH, COORDINATORS OF PURDUE TECHNOLOGY  
PROGRAMS AT INDIANA UNIVERSITY AT SOUTH BEND,  
WILL PRESENT THE CANDIDATES.**

(DEAN GENTRY, DR. PERUSICH, and MR. BARKER rise, peak caps, and move to the lectern. CHANCELLOR COHEN returns the gesture and resumes seat. DEAN GENTRY stands at lectern; DR. PERUSICH and MR. BARKER stand at side microphones.)

DR. PERUSICH: **WILL THE CANDIDATES FOR THE DEGREE  
ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE IN ELECTRICAL  
ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY PLEASE STAND.**

**MR. BARKER: WILL THE CANDIDATES FOR THE DEGREE ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE IN MECHANICAL ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY PLEASE STAND.**

**DR. PERUSICH: DEAN GENTRY, THESE CANDIDATES HAVE SUCCESSFULLY FULFILLED THE REQUIREMENTS OF ONE OF THE TWO-YEAR CURRICULA IN THE SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY. ► WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE FACULTY, THEY ARE NOW PRESENTED TO YOU TO RECEIVE THE DEGREE ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE.**

**DEAN GENTRY: IN THIS PRESENCE, OBSERVING THE CUSTOM OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, EXERCISING THE AUTHORITY OF THE TRUSTEES OF PURDUE UNIVERSITY, LEGALLY VESTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF INDIANA; UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE FACULTY AND ACTING FOR THE PRESIDENT OF PURDUE UNIVERSITY, I NOW**

**CONFER UPON YOU WHO HAVE FULFILLED THE  
REQUIREMENTS OF ONE OF THE TWO-YEAR  
CURRICULA IN APPLIED TECHNOLOGY, THE DEGREE  
ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE, WITH ALL THE  
RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES APPERTAINING THERETO  
HERE AND ELSEWHERE. ► I ALSO SOLEMNLY  
PLACE UPON YOU THOSE OBLIGATIONS WHICH YOU  
MUST HENCEFORTH ASSUME AS RECIPIENTS OF THIS  
DEGREE. ► AS EVIDENCE OF THIS DEGREE AND  
YOUR ABILITY TO FULFILL ITS OBLIGATIONS, YOU WILL  
RECEIVE AN APPROPRIATE DIPLOMA. ► PLEASE BE  
SEATED.**

(DEAN GENTRY, MR. BARKER, and DR. PERUSICH resume  
seats and CHANCELLOR COHEN moves to side lectern.)

**CHANCELLOR COHEN: THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY  
CANDIDATES—INCLUDING THOSE WHO EXPECT TO  
GRADUATE AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE 1988  
SUMMER SESSION—WILL BE PRESENTED BY THE**

**CHAIRPERSONS AND DIRECTORS OF THE ACADEMIC  
UNITS AND THE DEANS OF THE UNIVERSITY SCHOOLS.**

**▶ CANDIDATES WHO BY VOTE OF THE FACULTY HAVE  
BEEN TENTATIVELY AWARDED HONORS IN GENERAL  
SCHOLARSHIP ARE DISTINGUISHED BY FOURRAGERES,  
WHICH ARE CORDS WORN FROM THE LEFT SHOULDER.**

**▶ CREAM AND CRIMSON CORDS REPRESENT  
HIGHEST DISTINCTION. ▶ CREAM CORDS  
REPRESENT HIGH DISTINCTION. ▶ CRIMSON CORDS  
REPRESENT DISTINCTION.**

**THE UNIVERSITY IS PROUD OF ALL HER GRADUATES AND  
TAKES AN ADDED MEASURE OF PRIDE IN THOSE WHO  
HAVE EXCELLED ACADEMICALLY; THEREFORE, I ASK  
THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH “HIGHEST  
DISTINCTION” PLEASE TO STAND AND REMAINING  
STANDING. (pause)**

**WILL THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH “HIGH

**WILL THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH “DISTINCTION”**

**PLEASE STAND.** (pause-leads applause). ► **PLEASE BE SEATED.**

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to lectern. CHANCELLOR COHEN remains at the side lectern.)

CHANCELLOR COHEN: **I NOW INVITE DR. ROBERT L.**
