

# INDIANA UNIVERSITY SUMMER CLASSES

## SOUTH BEND — MISHAWAKA CENTER

*June 16 - August 23, 1947*

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Enrollment begins June 12 and continues through June 18 after which a late enrollment fee of \$2 is added. Classes limited in size. Early enrollment advised. Seven to nine semester hours constitute a regular full-time program, but ten hours may be taken if required to complete a satisfactory schedule. Those employed full-time should generally not take more than a two or three hour course. Classes may be cancelled if enrollment is inadequate or if an instructor becomes unavailable; other classes will be added when needed if an appropriately qualified instructor is available. Fees must be paid in full at time of enrollment and are at the rate of \$5 per semester hour for residents of Indiana and \$10 per semester hour for non-residents. In a few courses a small laboratory fee is also charged. Limited refunds available until July 12 upon approved withdrawals resulting from written applications therefor. The policy concerning admission of new students and acceptance of students on transfer is stated in the current bulletin. All classes will be held in South Bend Central High School.

**VETERANS:** Veterans must carry a minimum of seven semester hours to be eligible for full subsistence. Veterans not enrolled at the Center during the academic year 1946-1947 should arrange to receive appropriate authorization for study at the Center in advance of enrollment. Under present procedure of the Veterans Administration (April 1947) veterans already enrolled during academic year 1946-47 do not need further authorization to enroll unless they were enrolled elsewhere during the second semester. Veterans lacking such authorization will be required to pay for fees and books involved but refund of same will be made upon presentation of proper authorization from the Veterans Administration. Veterans having special questions may call at the office of the Center or confer with Mr. W. H. Tolle at the Veterans Center on the sixth floor of the Whitcomb and Keller Building in South Bend.
