Globalization of the US: From Digital Research Project to Digital Library Services

As part of an exhibition at the Lilly Library entitled The Globalization of the United States, 1789-1861 scheduled to open September 15, historian Konstantin Dierks and librarians Erika Dowell and Michelle Dalmau have partnered to create a digital counterpart to the physical exhibit that includes an interactive, map-based visualization. The visualization tracks several data points or "facets" about U.S. interventions in the rest of the globe, from diplomatic missions to stationed military squadrons. As Dierks describes, it provides a tool for scholars and students to investigate how "the United States, no longer swaddled within the British empire, sought to recalibrate its interaction with the wider world as an independent nation."

Gordon Lynn Hufford to Retire

At the end of January 2015, Lynn Hufford will retire after 33 years of providing excellent leadership, service, and professional contributions to Indiana University. Lynn began his career at IU in February 1982 as the Director of the Library at the IU East campus. He remained at IUE until April of 2004 when he accepted the position of University Electronic Resources Administrator on the Bloomington campus, a position he held until he was appointed as Head of the E. Lingle Craig Preservation Lab in 2007.

During Lynn's tenure at IU East, he was involved in many campus committees, projects, and changes -- both within the Library and on the campus. When IUE's mission changed from an Associate degree granting institution to a Baccalaureate degree campus, funds were received to support the expansion from a single building to a multiple building campus. Lynn was actively involved in the new library's construction project and in the expansion of the library's collections which roughly tripled in size under his stewardship. In addition to directing the Library, Lynn was elected President of the IUE faculty senate, chaired the Curriculum Committee, served on both the IUE and IUL Promotion and Tenure Committees, and was appointed as IUE's first Assistant Vice Chancellor for Distance Education.

Throughout his career, Lynn has made many noteworthy service contributions particularly in his efforts to highlight the important role librarians need to play in developing present and future library leaders. For several years, he was an active member within the American Library Association's Library Administration and Management Association (LAMA), including serving as Chair of the Library Organization and Management Section (LOMS). When the IU School of Library and Information Science offered courses at the regional campuses, Lynn served as the coordinator of the program in Richmond and taught courses, most notably on library management. When Lynn came to Bloomington, his position as University Electronic Resources Administrator (UERA) was tasked to coordinate a new model involving the licensing and purchasing of electronic resources for all of the libraries within the IU system. In this role, Lynn also worked a great deal with the Academic Libraries of Indiana (ALI). Additionally, Lynn was asked to handle some of the early assessment efforts within the IU Libraries and served as chair of the Assessment Committee when the LibQUAL+ survey was conducted in 2006. His strong managerial and business skills, coupled with his understanding of the needs of donors, scholars, and the various units within the Libraries, have won Lynn well-deserved respect among the Preservation Lab staff and his fellow colleagues.

Please join me in thanking Lynn for his many years of devoted and outstanding service. We all wish you well in your retirement!
