Jo McClamroch to Retire

After 18 years of service to the IUB Libraries, Jo McClamroch will begin a much-deserved retirement on January 1, 2017. Jo has a BA in Linguistics and a MLS (both from Indiana University) and a MEd in Human Resource Development (Xavier University). After receiving her MLS, Jo held several library reference and public services positions across the Midwest before becoming the Head of Collection Development at Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio. Jo joined the IUB Libraries as Head, Halls of Residence Libraries, Undergraduate Library Services in 1998. As the library service migrated 12 libraries to the Halls of Residence, Jo continued to oversee operations for two years. A highlight of the period was her involvement in the interior design of the new HRL Library in the Wilkie Residence Hall. In 2001, she was named Head of Electronic Resources Acquisitions as the acquisition and licensing of electronic journals and books increased dramatically. In 2008, her focus was concentrated on large publisher e-journal package licensing and acquisition with publishers such as Wiley, Springer, and Elsevier. More recently, Jo has been responsible for managing the acquisition of streaming video. She published a number of book reviews in *Library Journal* and articles in *Academic Librarian*. She was active in the Bloomington Library Faculty Council (BLFC) and the North American Serials Interest Group (NASIG).

Beyond the Libraries, Jo has been a very active volunteer in community programs such as the Monroe County Public Library's English as a Second Language Program and with the Area 10 Agency on Aging's reading program for nursing home residents. An animal lover, she worked with the Bloomington Animal Shelter to foster and socialize cats and dogs to assist with their future adoption. Most recently, she has been involved with the Interfaith Winter Shelter. In retirement she plans to continue her many community volunteer activities, flower gardening, and relaxing with her two cats. Please join me in wishing Jo all the best in her retirement!
