Indiana University Bloomington's digital library collections are moving repository versions from Fedora 3 to Fedora 4. This move means switching from using XML files for descriptive, technical, and structural metadata to using RDF statements defining those same descriptive, technical, and structural metadata properties. This talk will cover the analysis work so far to understand our collection models in Fedora 3 and identify patterns we might use for this metadata migration. Additionally, migration work to Fedora 4 is occurring for systems that have been external to the Fedora repository and those results will also inform

## Upcoming Application Deadline for the InULA Grants Fund

Need monetary support for research or research-related activities? The InULA Grants Fund is intended to encourage and support research by providing funding for projects of any size or scope. Grant applications are now being accepted through October 16, 2017. You must be a current member of InULA to be eligible. The InULA Grants and Scholarship Committee will review grant applications using a rubric. In the case of equally meritorious proposals, those of non-tenured librarians may be given priority because it is often difficult for beginning researchers to obtain research grants. Recommendations will then be made to the InULA Executive Board for approval and funding. Notice of awards is provided to applicants as soon as possible.

Can't get an application in by October 16? Other fund deadlines are January 15, 2018 and April 15, 2018.

## SirsiDynix Symphony Upgrade

### SirsiDynix Symphony Upgrade to 3.5.2.1 October 7-8; WorkFlows, IUCAT Offline

A SirsiDynix Symphony system upgrade from our current version 3.5.1 to version 3.5.2.1 will occur the weekend of October 7-8, 2017.

Additionally, both IUCAT and IUCAT Classic will be offline during the upgrade. For this reason, access to search & browse, requesting, and patron My Account information will be unavailable. During the downtime, call number and location information will be available via guest access to IU Bloomington's [OneSearch@IU](#). A banner message announcing this downtime will be added to both catalog interfaces in mid-September.

During the upgrade process, the Symphony WorkFlows Staff Client will be unavailable. All circulation points will need to plan to use alternative methods for circulation on Sunday, October 8 or have a plan for upgrading their Workflows software after the upgrade is complete. The upgrade will take place during the regular IUCAT maintenance window Sunday, October 8 (2:00am-10:00am). We will notify everyone as soon as the new WorkFlows Staff Client is available for use.

A system-wide testing team led by Spencer Anspach, Amy Bailey, Lynda Clendenning, and Randy Lent at IUB are working to test the new version to ensure that it is thoroughly tested across all Symphony functional modules. Thanks also to all of our additional IUB team members and other campus testing partners at IUPUI and South Bend.

This upgrade will require a new Symphony WorkFlows Client to be installed prior to use on October 8 after the upgrade is finished. ## **IUCAT Classic Retirement Scheduled for December 17, 2017**

IUCAT Classic will be deactivated effective Sunday, December 17 following the completion of the fall semester.

All of the major functions of the SirsiDynix user interface are now available via the IUCat Blacklight interface (<https://iucat.iu.edu>) including browse and course reserves. Alternate access for the few remaining staff-only functions that require the SirsiDynix OPAC will continue to be available (more details to come on this aspect).

Our communication plan regarding the retirement is as follows:

- October 15: Banner announcing the retirement date will be added to IUCAT Classic. A notification will be added to the IT Notices calendar. A news item will be posted on the IU Bloomington Libraries' website.
- November 15: Additional notifications added within IUCAT Blacklight interface regarding IUCAT Classic retirement

Following the retirement through the end of spring semester 2018, visitors to <http://classic.iucat.iu.edu> will reach a page that describes options available via the IUCAT Blacklight interface and directs them there.
