Since the presidency of Franklin Roosevelt, the first 100 days of an administration has been used as a measuring stick to estimate the ability of a new president to govern. This is still true today. The first 100 days of the Trump administration invoked strong sentiment both for and against his policies. However, was the sentiment generally positive or negative or neutral? Using different sentiment analysis algorithms and Trump's favorite social media platform, Twitter, we scraped over 181,000 English language tweets between January 20, 2017 and April 29, 2017 to get an idea of Twitter user sentiment regarding the new Commander-in-Chief during his first 100 days.

While our results reveal an interesting snapshot of the heightened emotions of the first 100 days of this presidency, they also raised some concerns regarding the bias inherent in the sentiment analysis process. More specifically, in the different dictionaries used to determine which words are "positive" and which words are "negative" issues of bias regarding race, gender, sexuality, and religion emerge. Therefore, it's important to "look underneath the hood," even when using a vetted dictionary, to examine the assumptions made, tweak the dictionary, and make transparent any assumptions left in the lexicon.

SirsiDynix Symphony Upgrade

SirsiDynix Symphony Upgrade to 3.5.2.1 October 7-8; WorkFlows, IUCAT Offline

A SirsiDynix Symphony system upgrade from our current version 3.5.1 to version 3.5.2.1 will occur the weekend of (October 7-8, 2017).

Additionally, both IUCAT and IUCAT Classic will be offline during the upgrade. For this reason, access to search & browse, requesting, and patron My Account information will be unavailable.

During the downtime, call number and location information will be available via guest access to IU Bloomington's OneSearch@IU.

A banner message announcing this downtime will be added to both catalog interfaces in mid-September.

During the upgrade process, the Symphony WorkFlows Staff Client will be unavailable. All circulation points will need to plan to use alternative methods for circulation on Sunday, October 8 or have a plan for upgrading their Workflows software after the upgrade is complete. The upgrade will take place during the regular IUCAT maintenance window Sunday, October 8 (2am-10am). We will notify everyone as soon as the new WorkFlows Staff Client is available for use.

A system-wide testing team led by Spencer Anspach, Amy Bailey, Lynda Clendenning, and Randy Lent at IUB are working to test the new version to ensure that it is thoroughly tested across all Symphony functional modules. Thanks also to all of our additional IUB team members and other campus testing partners at IUPUI and South Bend.

This upgrade will require a new Symphony WorkFlows Client to be installed prior to use on October 8 after the upgrade is finished. If you have questions about the new software client or distribution on your campus, please contact Spencer Anspach (sanspach@indiana.edu).

Key dates to keep in mind regarding the upgrade are as follows:

- **October 7, 2017** - Plan to have your excess circ returns and any other processing in WorkFlows finished by close of business on Saturday October 7, 2017.
- **October 8, 2017** - Production Upgrade Window (2am-10am): WorkFlows client unavailable, manual circulation, no My Account services for patrons, IUCAT and IUCAT Classic unavailable (use OneSearch@IU)
