Reminder: IUCAT Classic Retirement Scheduled for December 17, 2017

IUCAT Classic will be deactivated effective Sunday, December 17 following the completion of the fall semester.

Next week a banner announcing the retirement date will be added to IUCAT Classic. A notification will be added to the IT Notices calendar; and, a news item will be posted on the IU Bloomington Libraries' website. On November 15 additional notifications added within IUCAT Blacklight interface regarding IUCAT Classic retirement.

Following the retirement through the end of spring semester 2018 visitors to <http://classic.iucat.iu.edu> will reach a page that describes options available via the IUCAT Blacklight interface and directs them there.

All of the major functions of the SirsiDynix user interface are now available via the IUCat Blacklight interface (<https://iucat.iu.edu>) including browse and course reserves. Alternate access for the few remaining staff-only functions that require the SirsiDynix OPAC will continue to be available (more details to come on this aspect).
