Named for William Evans Jenkins, former Chief Librarian of Indiana University, this award may be presented annually to a current or former librarian on the Bloomington campus, in recognition of their outstanding contributions to the Indiana University Libraries or to the library profession in general. All of the major functions of the SirsiDynix user interface are now available via the IUCat Blacklight interface (<https://iucats.iu.edu>) including browse and course reserves. We will continue to provide access for generating a SirsiDynix PIN (the remaining staff-only function that requires the SirsiDynix OPAC) through an alternate venue. Instructions for accessing this function post-Classic will be shared later this semester.

Thus far, we have added a banner announcing the retirement date will be added to IUCAT Classic; posted the information on the IT Notices calendar; posted a news item on the IU Bloomington Libraries' website; and sent multiple notifications, like this one, to staff statewide. Tim Larson Retires

It is with a mixture of regret and satisfaction that I announce Tim Larson's retirement on October 31 as the serial cataloger in Slavic and Eastern European languages. When Tim walked out the door on that final day, he took with him decades of cataloging experience, both monographic and serial, in a host of Western, Central, and Eastern European languages. During his long career, he led the retrospective conversion project for monographs and serials and has been indispensable as cataloging support for shelf-reading and inventory projects. He also supplied, single-handedly, Cyrillic alphabet characters, both in OCLC and locally, for all serial our serial records. He was a leading contributor of catalog records for Cyrillic titles in the Directory of Open-Access Journals. And, of course, Tim's sunny disposition will be sorely missed by all of us.
