Fall

- Launch an Engaged Faculty Fellows Program

 - Leadership discussion on Thursday, November 9, from 3:30-4:30
- Share our definition of community engagement with the main units on campus
- Work on a proposal for a Center for Community Engagement
- Work on a proposal to pay interns a stipend
- Plan a visit to University of Wisconsin Parkside to seek guidance on our Civic Action Plan

Spring

- Meet with highly engaged units on campus so they can anticipate our data requests
- Start to collect data for the Carnegie Engaged Campus Classification application (based on 2017-2018 year)
 - Reporting your community engagement on the DMAI (annual report) will be critical
