These changes will result in a more complete ability to modify and edit all search parameters for advanced search, increased capacity to construct complex searches, and a more streamlined interface for Advanced Search.

## Reminder: IUCAT Classic Retirement Scheduled for December 17, 2017

Greetings all, I'm back again with a reminder that IUCAT Classic will be deactivated effective Sunday, December 17 (following the completion of the fall semester).

On November 15 we added a notification within the IUCAT Blacklight interface 'Tools' menu, adjacent to the link to IUCAT Classic about the deactivation.

Following the retirement of Classic through the end of spring semester 2018, visitors to <http://classic.iucat.iu.edu> will reach a page that describes options available via the IUCAT Blacklight interface and directs them there.

All of the major functions of the SirsiDynix user interface are now available via the IUCAT Blacklight interface (<https://iucat.iu.edu>) including browse and course reserves. We will continue to provide access for generating a SirsiDynix PIN (the remaining staff-only function that requires the SirsiDynix OPAC) through an alternate venue. Instructions for accessing this function post-Classic will be shared later this semester.

Thus far, we have added a banner announcing the retirement date will be added to IUCAT Classic; posted the information on the IT Notices calendar; posted a news item on the IU Bloomington Libraries' website; and sent multiple notifications, like this one, to staff statewide. I am pleased to announce that Scott Libson has accepted the position of History Librarian. Scott will join the Arts and Humanities Department on February 5, 2018. Scott graduated from Columbia University with a B.A. in Archeology and from Yale University with a Master of Arts in Religion. In 2016, Scott earned a Ph.D in History from Emory University, with a dissertation that analyzed the history of philanthropy in the United States: "'Faith in Money': Mission Movement Fundraising and American Philanthropy, 1860-1930". His areas of expertise include American religious history, religion in relation to visual arts, as well as topics of American history more broadly.

At each institution where he studied, Scott worked in libraries and archives as a researcher and professional.
