For some undergraduate students, it can be increasingly difficult to distinguish fact from fiction in an online environment. On top of this, students can be so overwhelmed by the massive amount of information that they have problems finding and identifying accurate information for their research. Enter the Critical Thinking Online Toolkit.

As a series of assignments and modules in Canvas, this Toolkit provides materials for instructors across all IU campuses to help students hone their information literacy skills: identify and evaluate valid sources of information, synthesize that information, and construct and communicate knowledge for their academic work and everyday lives.

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## InULA Research Incentive Grant Fund Application Deadline

Need monetary support for research or research-related activities? The InULA Grants Fund is intended to encourage and support research by providing funding for projects of any size or scope. Grant applications are now being accepted through April 15, 2019. You must be a current member of InULA to be eligible. The InULA Grants and Scholarship Committee will review grant applications using a newly-revised [rubric](#). In the case of equally meritorious proposals, those of non-tenured librarians may be given priority because it is often difficult for beginning researchers to obtain research grants. Recommendations will then be made to the InULA Executive Board for approval and funding. Notice of awards is provided to applicants as soon as possible. Can't get an application in by April 15? The next fund deadlines will be October 15, 2019 and January 15, 2020.
