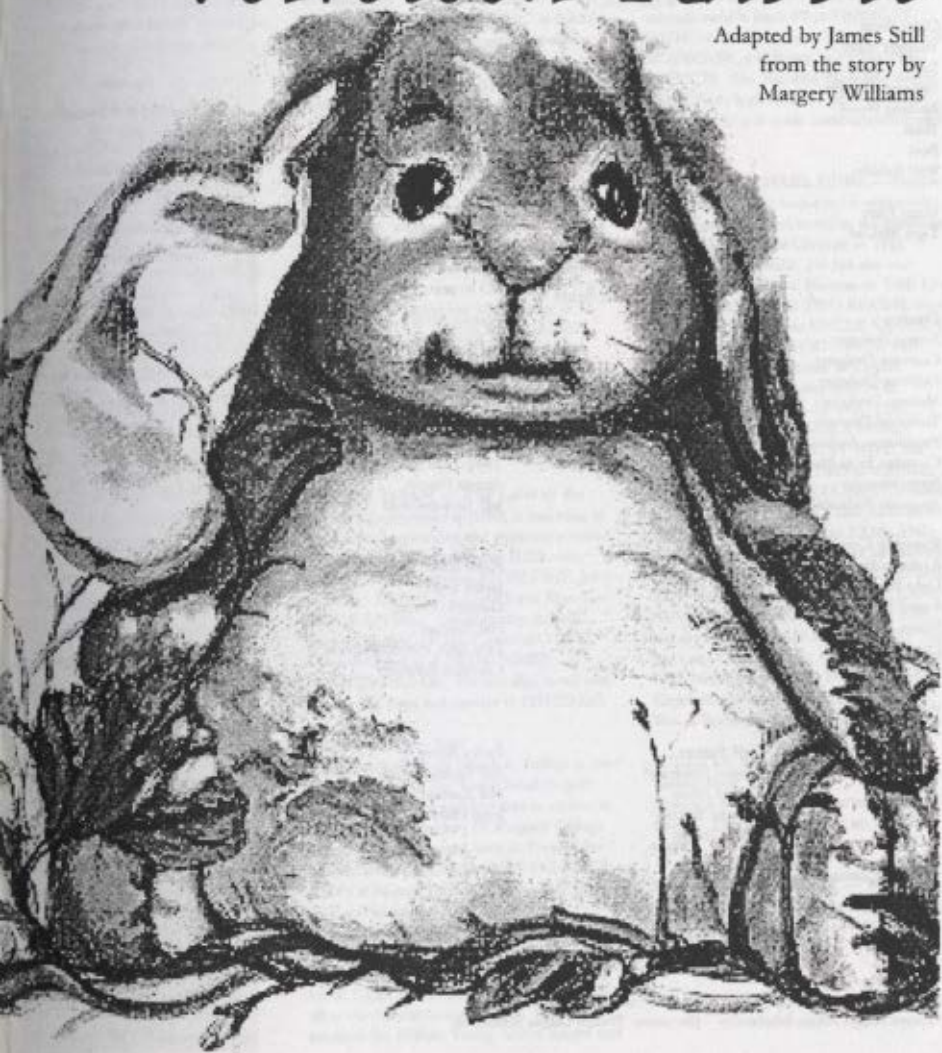

Haely also received the honors of "Best Actress", "Best Thespian" and "Honor Thespian" at Elkhart Central High School. She made her acting debut on the IUSB stage as Henriette in the fall production of *THE LEARNED LADIES*.

CARRIE L. HUNTER — *Tiger McGee*
Carrie, a former Kappa Kappa Kappa Scholarship recipient, is a Junior who plans on pursuing a career in the theatre. She has appeared on the IUSB stage as Imene in *ANTIGONE*, Armande in *THE LEARNED LADIES*, the Narrator in *CHARLOTTE'S WEB*, Mariya Vasilyevna Voinitskaya in *UNCLE VANYA*, Beulah Baxter in *MERTON OF THE MOVIES*, Elfie Fey in *STAGE BLOOD*, Gussie Hickman in *LYDIE BREEZE*, and Penelope in *SPACE ODYSSEY*. Carrie also appeared as Assistant in *AS YOU LIKE IT*, which featured her singing voice.

DAVID J. ISBAN — *Wild Rabbit*
David, a Sophomore at IUSB, is majoring in Theatre and Business. His IUSB roles include Second Guard in *ANTIGONE*, Julien in *THE LEARNED LADIES* and Man Two in *THE LIVING*. Art Center, both in Turkey. He has performed as Coles in *MRS. GIBBER'S BOYS* at Mimus Theatre, Red Kit in *RED KIT* at The Story and Reality Theater, Barman in *BROKER WORLD*, the little boy, teenager, and the old man in *MARRIAGE PLAY*, the old dictator in *IS THERE ANYONE ELSE* and Romi in *SHEAKSY PLAY*, all at the Mujdat Gezer Theater. He also received the Milliyet Young Actors Award and

the ISTEK award. Alper made his IUSB acting debut as Ariste in *LEARNED LADIES*.

KRISTY MILLER — *Assistant Stage Manager*
Kristy made her acting debut on the IUSB stage as Tessie Kearns in *MERTON OF THE MOVIES*. She was also a dresser for *THE LEARNED LADIES*, props mistress for *THE LIVING* and sound operator for *UNCLE VANYA*. Her other stage performances include juror #9 in *12 ANGRY WOMEN*, the librarian in *UP THE DOWN STAIRCASE*, and Eileen in *PERSONAL EFFECTS*. She also won the senior drama award at her high school. She is a sophomore, majoring in mass communication and theatre.
