During the 2007–2008 academic year the Indiana University Kokomo Faculty Senate Admission Committee conducted the following business:

- In July, 2007 members of the Admission Committee met with two candidates for readmission. Readmission, with stipulations, was granted to both candidates.
- In November, 2008 members of the Admission Committee met with three candidates for readmission. Readmission, with stipulations, was granted to each of these individuals.
- At the request of Jack Tharp, the Admission Committee presented a motion to the Faculty Senate to change the college preparatory unit requirement contained in current IU Kokomo admission standard from 28 to 30 units, effective in Fall 2009 This motion was approved by the Faculty Senate on April 21, 2008
- At the request of Jack Tharp, the Admission Committee presented a motion to the Faculty Senate to adopt the IU Kokomo campus-specific procedures he revised for implementation of the *Code of Student Rights, Responsibilities, and Conduct*, effective in Summer 2008. This motion was approved by the Faculty Senate on April 21, 2008.

In light of Allen Safianow's retirement in December, 2007, the Admission Committee conducted its business this past spring with only three members. It is our suggestion that four members be assigned to this committee prior to its mid-July meeting to interview individuals who have been doubly-dismissed from one or more post-secondary institution and are applying for admission to IU Kokomo. We strongly believe that the Admission Committee should be constituted such that there is at least one representative of each gender on the committee (that is: that committee membership be constituted of two males and two females, or three males and one female, or three females and one male).
