

2017-18 Campus Directions Committee (CDC)

October 13: The Chancellor charged the Committee to review the feasibility of existing goals and objectives, revise indicators, and add areas/activities not addressed by the Campus Strategic Plan.

Discussion addressed additional points: The Committee should consider relevant parts of the Blueprint for Regional IU Campuses. The primary audience for this review is our campus. For goals that have been achieved, the Committee may recommend subsequent goals, along with specific units to be involved. The Committee's review has the potential to frame campus conversations and aspirations in each goal area. Periodic review and updating of the Campus Strategic Plan are valuable activities from the perspective of the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The Committee may ask individuals and units for data and input, with assistance from Bini T. and Ken B.

The Committee began its review by taking stock of progress toward existing goals and objectives of the Campus Plan. Groups of 2-3 members reviewed each goal and corresponding objectives.

November 10: Most groups reported on the current status of their assigned goal and objectives. A December 1 meeting was scheduled to complete the reports and plan for the spring semester, when the Committee will develop recommendations for revising the Campus Strategic Plan.

December 1: The Committee completed its updates of progress toward the existing goals and objectives of the Campus Plan. In the spring semester, each group will develop prioritized recommendations related to its assigned goal and objectives. Ideally, the Campus Strategic Plan's goals and objectives will become more specific, measurable, achievable, realistic and time-related (SMART). The Committee will also examine forms and uses of dashboards in higher education, and perhaps refine our existing dashboard.

January 24: The Committee suggested revisions to its description, charge, and committee membership for the IU South Bend Academic Senate Constitution, which is being updated this academic year.

January 29-30: Committee members took part in meeting with representatives of the HLC as part of its review of our campus

March 9: The committee met to decide which objectives of the Campus Strategic Plan were to be revised or replaced based on our research and review. In the case of revision, the committee members were asked to present their suggestions for SMART-er goals to be presented at the next meeting.

April 13: At our final meeting of the semester, the committee reviewed a list of all the recommendations for revisions and updates to the Campus Strategic Plan compiled by the

members of the Campus Directions Committee. Those members for the 2017-2018 academic year were:
