Overview

MSEPS is a student-run, regional conference affiliated with the Association of Applied Sport Psychology. It is held each February at a Midwestern university. Students give all presentations (other than keynotes), offering an excellent venue for undergraduate research. Students learn about methods, data collection/analysis, disseminating results, publishing research, knowledge translation, and applied opportunities. Students network with fellow undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty, and practitioners.

Reflection and Assessment

At the conclusion of the MSEPS conference, students will complete a reflective paper. First, students will describe three instances where they applied classroom learning to understand presentation materials. Second, students will list three new sport/exercise psychology concepts learned at the conference. Third, students will describe one research methodology they found interesting. Fourth, students will provide a brief biography and summary of the discussion they had with five non-IUK conference attendees. Fifth, students will reflect on how the conference has helped them understand more about their academic journey as it relates to conducting research and potential career paths.
