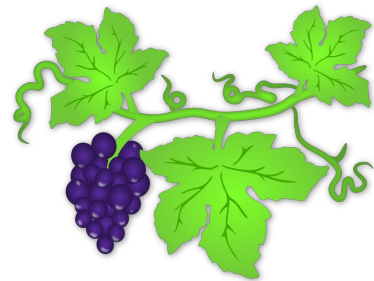

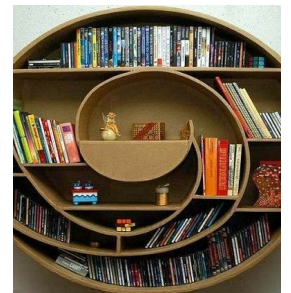

Are you an avid reader? Then consider joining the Book Circulating Group!

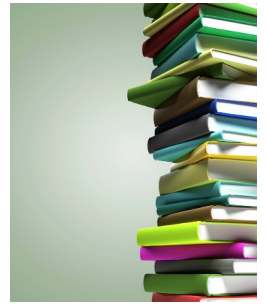
