a native of the South Bend Community and a distinguished, experienced artist-teacher, was the immediate choice for conductor when the South Bend Youth Symphony was formed in 1967. Full of enthusiasm and deep concern for the musical balance and growth of our Michiana young people, he teaches much more than the right notes in rehearsal. A fine instrumentalist in his own right with years of teaching experience, he has established an atmosphere conducive to real music education. Mr. Germano, a graduate of the Chicago Musical College, is a member of the music faculty at IUSB, orchestral director at John Adams High School, and was a founder of the South Bend Chamber Music Society. He is a former member of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra and has been seen frequently in professional performances. His own six children - all of whom play musical instruments - are testimonies to the enthusiasm and love with which he approaches both music and the talented young.
