#### Demand-Driven Acquisition Program Launch

The IUPUI University Library (I-UNIVLIB) is pleased to announce the implementation of its monographic Demand-Driven Acquisition (DDA) program. Known as “Books on Demand”, the program will operate by loading records into IUCAT to create a “pool” of titles from which IUPUI University Library users will be able to request the library purchase for the collection.

Records for this program will index as any other print title for IUPUI University Library. However, when users view a record from the program, it will look different in the following ways:

- It will have a red button near the top of the page that will display as “Get this for IUPUI”
- The location will display as “IUPUI University Lib. – Books on Demand”
- There will be a holdings note that displays as “Books on Demand is a service for University Library users only. Click ‘Get this for IUPUI’ button to initiate request.”

See <https://iucat.iu.edu/catalog/17073591> for a sample record. Note: the text of the button is from an earlier version. The updated text will display when the program goes live.

Titles in this collection will not be available for Request Delivery.

The program will go live on Tuesday, September 18, 2018.

This semester, Wells Library Cataloging Department managers will convene learn-and-share sessions on a variety of cataloging topics. The [Cataloging Topics Series](#) will provide forums for catalogers to hone their skills and troubleshoot their problematic cataloging situations with their colleagues. As such, session leaders will assume that participants are already familiar with cataloging. Session topics may include constructing authorized access points for titles, identifying serials and integrating resources, a how-to session on cataloging art exhibition catalogs, or best practices for cataloging government publications. One-hour sessions will encourage discussion and include an introduction of the cataloging topic, an overview of relevant standards and best practices, and examples.
