

Cycling Club at Indiana University Constitution 2018-19

Preamble

The Cycling Club at Indiana University brings riders together to compete for Indiana University-Bloomington in USA Collegiate Cycling Races. IUCC cyclists race in many USA Cycling disciplines including road racing, mountain, track, cyclocross, and BMX, however IUCC emphasizes competition in road racing and track racing.

Article I: General Provisions

Section 1: Name

This organization shall be called the Cycling Club at Indiana University (IUCC).

Section 2: Membership

Participation in the proposed organization must be without regard to arbitrary consideration of such characteristics as age, color, disability, ethnicity, gender, marital status, national origin, race, religion, sexual orientation, or veteran status. Members must pay club dues and purchase a current IUCC kit to compete in USA Collegiate A's and B's races.

Section 3: Executive Board

The governing body of the Cycling Club at Indiana University shall be an executive board as defined in Article II. The Executive Board shall have general authority over the actions of Indiana University Cycling Club and subject to the authority of this Constitution.

Section 4: Statement of University Compliance

This organization shall comply with all Indiana University regulations, and local, state, and federal laws. Anti-Hazing Policy: Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent. Furthermore, this organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation directly from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.

Article II: Officers

Section 1: Executive Board

This article will define the membership, powers, and responsibilities of the Indiana University Cycling Club executive board.

Section 2: Executive Board Members

The IUCC Executive Board shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary/Director of Sponsorship and Apparel, in addition to a Faculty Sponsor. All Executive Board Members will also be Safety Officers. Additional elected board members may also be added to the Executive Board if deemed necessary by a majority vote. The president shall serve as chairperson of the Executive Board and the administrative vice-president shall serve as vice-chairperson.

Section 3: Term of Office for Executive Board Members

The term of office for Executive Board members shall be from the date of the election until the next scheduled election, typically 1 calendar year. In the event of a vacancy, the term of office shall end at the time of the next election.
