

Resolution to Establish an Indiana University Bloomington Statewide Transfer General Education Core Certification

Be it Resolved that:

In order to comply with State Enrolled Act 182 and the Indiana Statewide Transfer General Education Core developed by the state educational institutions under the auspices of the Indiana Commission for Higher Education, the Bloomington Faculty Council

- (1) requests the Provost to arrange for the certification of a student as having completed the requirements of the Statewide Transfer General Education Core when the student has completed, with a GPA of at least 2.000,
 - (A) the Common Ground requirements of the Bloomington General Education program,
 - (B) a course that satisfies the learning outcomes of the Speaking and Listening competency of the Indiana Statewide Transfer General Education Core,
 - (C) and, if necessary in order to attain 30 credit hours of General Education course work, additional courses approved for the Common Ground;

and

- (2) charges the General Education Committee, by May 1, 2013, to coordinate with the Schools the development a list of courses that satisfy the learning outcomes of the Speaking and Listening competency of the Indiana Statewide Transfer General Education Core and the assessment metrics for these courses.

This resolution is intended to be an interim measure that does not reflect on the recommendations of any committee with respect to changes in the Indiana University Bloomington General Education Program. More specifically, the details of how the STGEC requirements of a 2.000 GPA, a 30 credit hour minimum, and a Speaking and Listening competency will be reflected in the IUB General Education Program are still to be finalized. These details must be completed by the BFC by December 15, 2013.
