In response to critiques of Information Literacy Standards, ACRL recently approved a new Framework for Information Literacy that centers on higher order thinking and conceptual understandings. The Framework presents both opportunities and challenges to librarians in relation to teaching and learning. In this webinar, participants will be introduced to the Framework and to key concepts that inform it. Attendees will also consider potential applications of the Framework to library instruction and to librarianship more broadly.

Andrea Baer is the Undergraduate Education Librarian at Indiana University-Bloomington, where she works with course instructors and fellow librarians to integrate information literacy into teaching and learning. Andrea also teaches professional development courses on information literacy at Library Juice Academy.
