

Interruption of an Election (both EC and Chair):

The members of the EC agreed unanimously that the following policies regarding the nomination and election of new EC members or a new chairperson should become effective immediately:

Once an election process has begun (by the distribution of nomination ballots), it cannot be interrupted by subsequent changes in eligibility of any person.

This is taken to mean that ballots sent out will not be recalled unless there was a mistake in them.
