### Program Notes

Lakeshore High School is located in Stevensville, Michigan on the shores of Lake Michigan about 30 miles northwest of South Bend. The Band program at Lakeshore consists of almost 700 students in grades 5 -12 with 7 concert bands, middle school and high school jazz bands, pep band and a large ensemble program. The High School Marching Band has finished in the top 5 at the state Marching Festival for the last 6 years. The Symphonic Band was a guest of Western Michigan University last March for their Wind and Percussion Seminar featuring composer Robert Cichy. The band program is under the direction of Mrs. Lori VonKoenig. The Lakeshore percussion ensembles have been a long standing tradition at Lakeshore. The ensemble is a volunteer group and does all of it's rehearsing outside of class time. The percussion ensembles have regularly received the highest ratings at both district and state level. They have premiered several compositions in recent years. In December and February, the group recorded 12 compositions for a forth coming CD. Mr. Ronald Hull is the director of the Lakeshore Percussion ensembles. He is currently Artist in Residence at Lakeshore schools as well as St. Joseph, Michigan and Niles Brandywine schools. He is Adjunct Professor of Music at Andrews University in Berrien Springs, Michigan and on the instructional staff of Lake Michigan College, Benton Harbor, Michigan. Mr. Hull has performed with symphony orchestras, jazz bands, Broadway shows, and many bands over the last 25 years. He has performed in Europe, and many parts of the United States. He is a busy soloist, adjudicator, clinician, and performer. He is percussion arranger for several marching bands, has several compositions for percussion ensembles and regularly teaches more than 50 students.
