



If for any reason a member needs to be removed from the organization, this will be administered by the faculty advisor.

Article VI: Officer Appointments

Officer appointments will be selected and finalized by the faculty advisor.

Article VII: Non-Hazing

Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.

Article VIII: Dues & Budgets

There are no dues charged by the organization for membership. The budget shall be maintained by the elected Treasurer, in correspondence with the faculty advisor.

Article IX: Finances

This group shall apply for a Student Organization Account, in accordance with the Student Organization Accounts office policies and procedures.

Article X: Personal Gain Clause

This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.

Article XI: Amendments

All amendments to this Constitution must be approved by 2/3 of the membership. Proposed amendments will be sent to current members by email as well as announced during studio class.

Article XII: Programs Involving Children

This organization, when working with children, will be aware of and abide by the University's Programs Involving Children (PIC) Policy.

Article XIII: International Travel

This organization, when traveling internationally, will coordinate their travel through the Office of Overseas study.
